County being of a perfect mind & memory but weakness of body doth
make this my last will & Testament committing my body to Glorious
Power of Almighty, Hoping that at my Departure of this uncertain state of
life to join in Everlasting glory through Jesus our Lord with whose Blessing
I commit my body to the ground and my soul to the Lord of life. Unto my
son John Hainsworth a tract of land containing 300.50 acres out of
which said tract it is my desire that to his Bro^r Henry shall be given
one Hundred also two porcel mares Branded R. H. two cows branded R. H.
mark thus with a Swallow fork in the right ear & under keel also a
Crop in the left. also any horse mare or Calf Cow or Calf or Steer having
the Brand of a Roman I are this property also all that is of this mark is
his with a swallow fork and an under keel in the right ear & in the
left an over slope and an under Rapey, also one feathered keel / pair of
Blanketts, all the Hogs that is of the same mark of the cattle is his also
to my son Henry one Bay mare Branded R. H. with a mare Calf Brand
ded with a single R. which is his own brand all the cattle that is
marked with a swallow and an under keel in the right ear a half crop
taking of the upper side and Brand with a single R all of that mark
and Brand is his property and all the Hogs that is of the mark of
the cattle is his also, to my Daughters Margaret & Mary all the Horses
and mares that is branded C. H. in one is their's also all the cattle
that is of that brand is their property marked with a swallow and
an under keel in the right ear in the left a half crop taking out
of the underside. Each of them a Featherbed and all the Hogs of
that mark to be their property and all to be all Equally divided
between them two. To my son James Hainsworth this plantation
which I now live upon also a porcel mare two years old blaze
face Branded with R. H. two Heifer Calves with a swallow Fork in
the Right and under keel in the left a Crop and two slits a two
year old Heifer all white but the head that all black also it is
my desire that his mother shall have her life on the plantation
to Elizabeth Hainsworth one young mare to be branded
of our Spring two cows and Calves to be Branded for her next
Spring and one yearling she has now. I desire to my child
not yet born may be given to it four calves if it lives
It is my desire that if he or she should die that their shares
should be Equally divided among all the rest I desire
that none of these legacies shall be sold but as they come

of age they may draw of their shares to themselves. To my true and loving Elizabeth Haynesworth whose maiden name was Elizabeth there whom may be hers all the mares and horses kind with cattle dogs with one feather bed which she now sleeps upon and furniture also a negro man called Buck and a piece of land at Edisto containing fifty acres the right in her name with Pots and potten and all my household stuff it may be her property & at her decease may be equally divided among all the rest of my children and with whom I sign this as my last will desiring that those persons mentioned as Executors -

Ann & Elizabeth Walker my two daughters To be equally divided
between them share and share alike, or to the Survivor of them
Absolutely for Ever, that is to say in Case either should die
before they attain full age or day of marriage: And its further my will
that in Case both of my two Daughters Ann and Elizabeth should die
before they attain full age or day of Marriage, then I will & I here-
by give devise and Bequeath all the said Residue & Remainder of
my Estate both Real & Personal, Entended for my said Daughters
unto my nephews Charles & Thomas Walkers & James Walker Sons
of my Bro^r Charles Walker to be equally divided share & share
alike between the said Charles & Thomas & James, To hold to them
their heirs and assigns for Ever. And I hereby nominate & appoint
my said two Daughters Ann & Elizabeth Walkers Executors &
Peter Mangach Esq^r of Charles Town my Executor of this my
last will & Testament hereby revoking all former Will or Wills
by me at any time heretofore made declare this only to be
