 in case she should not be alive at my decease then I
 give devise and bequeath the said rest residue and
 remainder of my Estate real and personal unto the
 above named James and Benedict Wright to be shared
 equally between them share and share alike and to
 their heirs Executors and Administrators forever.
 Item it is my will and Express desire that all the
 legacies herein by me given and bequeathed be remitted
 in good Bills of Exchange to the legacies aforesaid by
 my Executors hereafter named as soon as possible after
 my decease. And lastly I hereby nominate constitute
 and appoint my friends Messrs John Chapman
 William Price of Charles Town in the Province aforesaid
 Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby
 repeating all former and other wills and wills by me
 heretofore made in Witness whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and seal this 23rd day of March in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty four
 and in the fourth year of his majestys Reign.
