and in order thereto I hereby fully authorize and empower my said Executors
to sell the whole or any part or parcel of my Estate Real and Personal
and to make titles to any lands they shall sell or dispose off.
Item I give and bequeath unto my Honoured mother Anna McDonald two
hundred pounds Current money to be paid her yearly and every year
during the term of her natural life. Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved
Wife Frances Pawley all the residue and remainder of my Estate both
real and Personal to her her heirs Executors Administrators and assigns forever
And I do hereby nominate and appoint my beloved wife Frances Pawley
to be Executrix and my beloved Brothers in law Joseph Allston and John
Allston Executors of this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof
I do hereunto set my hand & seal this sixteenth of September in the
Year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred and sixty two

being weak and infirm in Body but of perfect and sound sense & memory
(Blessed be God therefore) do hereby revoking all former wills by me made this
twelfth day of February in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred
and sixty two, constitute, ordain and appoint this my last Will & Testament
in manner and form following (that is to say)
Imprimis I commend my soul unto Almighty God who gave it me, and my
Body to the Earth from whence it came in hopes of a joyful resurrection
through the merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ, And as for that Movable
Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me I dispose thereof as followeth
First I give to my beloved wife Mary Stereus my Riding Chace and Horse
called Honey
Item I give my whole Personal Estate to be equally divided betwixt my
said wife Mary Stereus and my five Children (viz) William Stereus, David
Stereus, Joseph Stereus, Elizabeth Stereus and Mary Stereus all my
just debts being first fully paid & answered.
Item I give to my beloved sons William Stereus and David Stereus one tract
of land containing five hundred acres lying upon a Swamp called Good
land Swamp, to be equally divided betwixt them. Item I give to my
beloved son Joseph Stereus one tract of land containing one hundred
acres joining to the aforesaid tract of land.
