In the Name of God amen
I John Saunders of St Bartholomew Parish being weak and low
in Body but of sound and perfect memory calling to mind the
certainty of death and the uncertainty of the time thereof, think
best to make this my last will and testament in the following
manner, That is to say I wish and principally I recommend my
soul to God the Creator thereof. Looking for salvation by the
merit of my Saviour Jesus Christ and my body to be buried
at the discretion of my Executor, and as touching such worldly
estate which I have played God to bestow me with I give
bequest and dispose of in the following manner and form
whimsoe I desire that all my just debts and funeral
charges be first paid and discharged out of my Estate; by my
Executor Item I give and bequeath unto Capt Joseph
Homer one black Riding Horse and my Scutcheon to him and
his Heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto Mr.
Allen Atkinson one small bay Horse and my best guns
to him and his Heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath
unto Mrs Mary Wilson daughter of to Coll^r Major Wilson deceased
one

one negroe Woman named Jenny, one negroe girl named, Gata, one
negroe girl named Nanny, One Negrito woman named Phillis
and her child named Jenny I do further give the said Mary Wilson
all my real, and the residue of my personal Estate, which I shall die
possessed of or in any ways whatsoever devittuted unto to be paid her at
the age of Eighteen years or the day of marriage by my Executor, to
have and to hold the above five negroes with all my Lands, and
Residue of my Estate unto the said Mary Wilson to her and her
heirs forever. I do hereby give my Executor hereafter named full
powers to sell and dispose of any part or all my lands, if he thinks
proper for the use of the said Mary Wilson and I do hereby allow
the Power made by my Executor to be good and sufficient
party of my hereby Constitute and appoint Capt Joseph Cloer
to be my Executor of this my last will and testament revoking
Renouncing and disowning all former wills & testaments made by
me and acknowledge this to be my last will and testament I have
hereunto set my hand and fixed my seal this Twenty eighth day
of February and in the year of our lord One thousand seven hundred
and fifty six.

the same shall go and be disposed of in such manner and
form as hereinafter respecting is mentioned limited and
appointed and no otherwise that is to say First I will and desire
that all my just debts and funeral expences shall be duly paid
and discharged Item I give devise and bequeath unto my
beloved wife Sarah Perkins and my beloved son John Perkins
all my personal estate whatsoeuer or whatsoever to be equally
divided between them to them and their heirs forever Item
I give devise and bequeath to my said John Perkins all my
real estate of what nature or kind whatsoever or wheresoever
belonging to him and his heirs forever But if it shall please God
that he my said son John shall die before his age twenty one
years and without issue lawfully begotten of his body in such
case I give devise and bequeath all my said real estate
unto my said beloved wife Sarah to her and her heirs and
descents forever Lastly I do nominate Constitute and appoint
my said beloved wife Sarah her heirs sole Executrix of this
my last will and Testament hereby revoking and making
null and void all former and other wills and Testaments by
me heretofore made or declared either by word or writing
ratifying allowing and confirming this, gulf no other to be and remain
as and for my only last Will and Testament In witness
whereof I the said Samuel Perkins have to this my said last
Will and Testament set my hand and seal the twenty eighth
day of March one thousand seven hundred and sixty four.
