one Thousand seven hundred and fifty nine I Sarah Brockington
of South Carolina in the Prince of Prince Frederick being Law in Body
but of a sound mind & memory Do make this my Last Will &
Testament in manner & form following That is to say first &
Principally I Commit my Soul to Almighty God my Creator my
Body to the Earth from whence it was Taken as for my Burial
I desire that it may be done without pomp or State at The
Discretion of my after named Executors as to my worldly Estate I
Will & positively order that all my just Debts be paid as soon as
my Executors hereafter mentioned shall be able to Discharge
the same. Item I give & Bequeath to my Loving Daughter
Elizabeth Hephurn my Bed bedding & Furniture Item I
give & Bequeath to my Loving Daughter Mary Jolley one Negro
Woman named Jennie Item I give & Bequeath to my Loving
Daughters Elizabeth Hephurn Mary Jolley Sarah Jane &
Hannah Cooke all my Wairing apparel such as Clothes Rings
Buttons Buttons to be Equally Divided Between Them shares
share alike - Item I give & Bequeath unto my loving children
John Brockington Mary Jolley Sarah Jane Elizabeth Hephurn
Hannah Cooke the sum of Two Hundred & Fifty Pounds current
money of South Carolina to be Divided Between Them share &
share alike to be paid to them by James Hephurn & Richard
Brockington at the expiration of Four Year time after my Decease.
Item I give & Bequeath to my son Richard Brockington one Negro
Boy named George on his Paying The one Half of the abov Legacy
of two hundred & fifty Pounds to be paid by him & Jas Hephurn as
abov Directed. Item I give & Bequeath to my son in Law
James Hephurn one Negro man named Coa pamen his paying
the one Half of the abov Legacy of two hundred & fifty Pounds
to be paid by him & Richard Brockington as abov Directed & Lastly
I Nominate & appoint my Loving Sons Richard Brockington & James
Hephurn Executors of This my Last Will In Witness Whereof I
have hereunto set my hand & Seal in presence two Witnesses & do hereby
Publish this to be my Last Will & Testament & Do revoke all other
Wills Whatsoever.

In the name of God Amen I Elisha Sorren
of Craven County in the Province of South Carolina Planter
being Weak in Body but of a Sound & Disposing mind memory &
understanding thanks be to God & considering the uncertainty of
Life it being appointed for all men to Die. Doe for the more
ease & satisfaction of my Wife & Children make & Declare this to be &
Certain my Last Will & Testament & First I Reun my Soul to
God who gave it & my Body to the Dust from whence it came
There to be Buried at The Discretion of my Executor in hopes of a
Resurrection to Eternal life & as to The Worldly Estate with which
it hath Pleased God to Bless me I Desire thereof as Follows
In primis I will that all my Just Debts & Funeral Expenses first
paid & Discharged. Item I give & Bequeath to my son Elisha
one Tract of Land containing seven Hundred acres lying on
Black River which my Father bought of Arthur Porter to
have & to hold said Tract of Land to him my said Son
Elisha & his Heirs and assigns for ever. Item I hereby empower
my Executors & Executive hereafter Named to sell & Dispose of
that Plantation or Tract of Land containing the Third part
of one Thousand acres more or less lying on Big Bee Tree
River & on land late James Micchie now Archibald Johnston
which my Father's Will Will appear & one new Boat which I
bought of Mr. Young & the third part of the old Boat & my
Silver Watch Either at Publick or private sale for the most
money they can get & the money arising by such sale to be
paid out for the advancement of my Estate at the Discretion
of my Executors. Item I give & Bequeath to my Beloved Wife
Rebecca Sorren one Riding horse & Furniture & Bed &
Furniture to her my said Wife Rebecca Sorren & her
Heirs & assigns for ever. Item I order & appoint that all
the Remainder of my Personal Estate Not heretofore
Bequeathed Consisting of Negroes, Stock of Black Cattle
Horses Hogs Household Furniture & Plantation Tools & shall be
Equally Divided Between my Beloved Wife Rebecca & my
Children Elisha & Hannah Sorren Each Share & Share alike
Item I order and appoint that Either of my Children
should happen to die Before they arrive at the age of Twenty one
Years & have no Lawful Issue my Will is that that part of
my Estate shall I send to my Brothers & Sister that Survives
my Children. Item my Will further is that the share
of my Personal Estate which shall fall to my beloved Wife
Rebecca may if she requires it be Delivered to her immediately

to my surviving child and if both of my
children should happen to die before
the age of twenty one years
and have no lawful issue
then that the share of my estate
shall be divided among my
brothers and sister that survive me
