Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute and Appoint John Gordon of Savannah in Georgia Esq<sup>r</sup> George Donnors Henry Lawrence and James Parsons of Charles Town Esq<sup>r</sup>s and Edward Newville of the same place Merchant and the Survivors or Survivor of them Executors and Executor of this my last Will and Testament and and Guardian and Guardian of the Persons and Estates of my Children respectively until they shall respectively become intitled to the Estate or Legacy hereby devised or bequeathed to them respectively.

And lastly I do hereby make and ordain John Braund of Charles Town Gentleman Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former and other wills by me at any time heretofore made ratifying & confirming this and no other to be my last Will & Testament In witness whereof I the said Sarah Smith have hereunto set my hand & seal the

Elizabeth Field, Alias Nichols, Georgia Field, Alias Scott, Charles Smith, Elizabeth Smith and John Eato Field, each and every to partake of an equal division And lastly I appoint & constitute my well beloved Brother William Field whole and sole Executor to this my Last Will & Testament In Virtue hereof I set my hand and seal this 8 day of December Anno Domini 1762
