January 20th. 1756 I Solomon Legare of Charles Town in the said Province goldsmith Bring in Bodily health & perfect Mind & memory Praised be God but Calling to remembrance the uncertain Estate of this Life & that all Flesh must yield unto Death when shall please almighty God to call & Being Desirous to settle my affairs & set my Family & house in order doe make Covenant & Declare this my last Will & Testaments Wills in manner & Form Following Revoking & annulling by these Presents all & every Testament Wills & Covenants by me made & Declared Either by Word or Writing & This is to be Taken only for my last Will & Testament & none other & first Being Penitent & Sorry for my Sins most most Humbly Desiring Forgiveness for the same I give & Commit my soul unto almighty God my savior & Redeemer in whom & by whose merit I trust & Believe assuredly to be saved & have Full Remission of all my offences & my Body to be Decently Buried at the Discretion of my executors here after named trusting that by the life of the resurrection of our blessed Saviour Lord Jesus Christ it shall arise with God the Father by the intercession of his only son has prepared for all his Chosen & now for settling my Temporal Estate such goods Chattels Debts & Credits as it hath pleased God graciously far above my desires to bestow upon me I do order give & Dispose the same in manner & form Following That is to say that all Thine Debts as I owe in right or Conscience to any persons whatsoever shall be Well & Truly Contented paid by my Executors here after named.

Item I give & Bequeath unto my son Solomon Legare & his heirs for ever my House I Bought of Daniel Bell & George Bell & what Negroes I shall Dye Possessed of.
Item I give and Bequeath unto my son Daniel Legare & his heirs for ever my House I Bought of Mr James Can Executors
Item I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Ellis one Thousand Pounds
Item I give & Bequeath unto my Three Grand Children of my Daughter Hanna Miller Mary Miller & Sarah Miller & Martha Miller Two hundred apiece
Item I give & Bequeath unto The reverend Mr. Smith Two Hundred Pound & to the Coffin house 200 Pound
Item My Will is That When you have leaved completed with what is mentioned above That what I shall have more movables or money or Bonds of Notes of hand due to me shall be equally Divided Between my you my son Solomon Legare & you my son Daniel Legare & my son Thomas Legare & if any one of you should Dye Before you be possessed of That I have ordered to Each of You my Will is That your Children shall have What ordered to you be equally Divided Between them For the Performance here of I Dew a Vint my son Solomon Legare & Daniel Legare my Lawful Executors &c

Buttons Buttons to be Equally Divided Between Them shares
share alike - Item I give & Bequeath unto my loving children
John Brockington Mary Jolley Sarah Jane Elizabeth Hephurn
Hannah Cooke the sum of Two Hundred & Fifty Pounds current
money of South Carolina to be Divided Between Them share &
share alike to be paid to them by James Hephurn & Richard
Brockington at the expiration of Four Year time after my Decease.
Item I give & Bequeath to my son Richard Brockington one Negro
Boy named George on his Paying The one Half of the abov Legacy
of two hundred & fifty Pounds to be paid by him & Jas Hephurn as
abov Directed. Item I give & Bequeath to my son in Law
James Hephurn one Negro man named Coa pamen his paying
the one Half of the abov Legacy of two hundred & fifty Pounds
to be paid by him & Richard Brockington as abov Directed & Lastly
I Nominate & appoint my Loving Sons Richard Brockington & James
Hephurn Executors of This my Last Will In Witness Whereof I
have hereunto set my hand & Seal in presence two Witnesses & do hereby
Publish this to be my Last Will & Testament & Do revoke all other
Wills Whatsoever.
