Susanna & William their parts & dividend of the Estate be paid at Interest or other ways laid out to the best advantage for them till they arrive to the age of twenty one years complete & that then their parts be delivered to them. All my remaining apparel I give & bequeath to my loving daughter Susanna Smith as her property & thereby revoke all other & former Will or Wills by me at any time heretofore made I'm Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this tenth Day of October in the 7th year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & sixty one.
