In The Name of God amen I Thomas Corder of Berkeley County in the Province of South Carolina Gentl being of perfect mind and memory Thanks be to God but calling to Remembraunce the Mortaliety of my body and that it is appinted unto all men once to dye do make and Ordain This my last Will and Testamente, that is to say Principally and First of all I give and Recommand my soule to the hands of Almighty God that gave it becouching him to Sarcine me all my sinnes through the Merits of Jesus Christ my ever blessed Saviour and Redemeer and my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the General resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to to Bless me in this life I give Devise & Bequeath the same in manner following In witness I will and Ordin I give and Discharged Item I give and Bequeath unto my dear & well beloved wife Anne Corder the sum of Three Thousand Five hundred pounds current money of South Carolina and orowman Slave named Muster Moley and her childe fistelle with their Servs and increase also all and Singulair my Household goodes and furnitire of what kind and nature whatsover silver plate That came fro me my Father onely excepted together with a chain and Gold able Ringe with the hanmer and all necessary accouterments to my said Wife Anne Corder her Heirs Executors and Administrators & Assigns forever and it is my will and Order that that my said dear Wife Anne Corder shall have the use of Five negroe and may Peaceably and quickly live and reside in the Dwelling House & upon the plantation whereon I do now live and to plant & tenuer for and during her widhood and no longer Item I give and Bequeath unto my well beloved sister Mrs Catherine Corder and her five children Eleanor Corder Catherine Corder John Corder Thomas Corder Mary Corder the sum of two Thousand Five hundred pounds Current money at South Carolina to be kept at Interest and taking security and divided betwee them share and share alike and to their own proper use benefit and behaf both if any of the said Children Eleanor, Catherine, John, Thomas and Mary shoued die before they be married or of age then I do give & Bequeath her lie or their respetive share and devision as apainid unto the survivors or survivor of them the said Eleanor, Catherine, John, Thomas and Mary to be equally shared and divided between them and to their Heirs Executors Administrators & Assigns

Item I give and Bequeath unto my well Beloved Sister Mrs Elizabeth Poncher the sum of five hundred Pounds Current Money of South Carolina to be by her freely used forswed Expences and dispeas of her Pleasure. Item I give and Bequeath my little serton mounted Gun to the eldest male bearing the name of the Testator as they shall surrone one another Item I give the sum of two Thousand Pounds to be kept at Interest for the uses of the Poor in St. Johns Parish in Berkley County Item I give and Bequeath unto my well Beloved Brother Mr James Corder my now slaves Charles to his own Proper use Bequeath & Rehooft. Item I give and Bequeath all the remainder of my slaves new women and Children with them and every one their issues and Increases together with all & singular my Stockes of Horses Mares &c Black Cattle with all the uttensils Tools Carriages and Tackling belonging or in any wise appertaining to my plantation unto my well beloved Brothers Mess^{rs} Samuel Corder & James Corder to be equally shared and Deviced between them share and share alike to them in Equal portion their Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns for ever Lastly I appoint Nominate & Constitute my Honoured Nuzel Mr James Corder and my well beloved Brother Mess^{rs} Sam^l Corder & James Corder to be Executors of this my last Will and Testamente and I do hereby utterly revoke disannul and make void all other Will or Wills Testemant or Testaments by me heretofore made acknowledging Ratifying and Confirming these Presents to be no other to be my last Will and Testamente In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the twenty second day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and sixty two.
