I Thomas Elliott senior in sound mind and memory Thanks be to God, Do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows In every thing in this my last Will: I first bequeath my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it, hoping for salvation from him that gave it.

First All my Just Debts and funeral Charges to paid & the rest as follows,

Item My Will is, That my son Jehu Elliott shall have the use of half the hoth in Charles Town, that George Ingles now lives on, from the Stable to Bedons street, and further my Will is that my son Jehu Elliott shall have the use of all the lands hereafter mentioned to him, The Tract he now lives on and part of several other Tracts joining it, Part of the Pine baron joining to Francis Daudridges and Thomas Smiths, and along the public Road till it joins the five hundred acre Tract on the West side of the public Road which is part of the Thousand acre Tract, and also the use of the land over Fox-fox River which was left to me by my Father which is Five hundred acres on the Horse Shoe Creek, and another Tract purchased by me

containing Three hundred and odd acres joining Southcut on the
Five hundred acre Tract and on the Horse Shoe Creek, and a
Tract of Land of Two hundred acres on Matthews Bluff on Savannah
River, and all the Lands that I possess on Town Neck part of Two
Tracts, which is called Long Point, and the above Lott & Lands
above mentioned to him to be, at his own Disposal, as he shall see
proper to give it to his Child or Children, if he has any to them
& their Heirs and Assigns for ever.

Item My Will is in case my Son John Elliott dies and leaves
no lawful Heirs of his Body, then all the above mentioned Lands
to him to be divided between my Two Daughters Children Mary
McKum & Sarah Elliott their Children to them and their Heirs
and Assigns for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son John Elliott the negroes
hereafter mentioned to him, Trumpeter and his wife Aabor, and
their children Little Trumpeter, Nicky, Tibbor, Sandy, Black Jacob & Boy
Bricklayer James, Ashley River Joe and his wife Peggy and
children Ben, Bess, Sarah, Minister George and wife Hannah
Menden and his wife Kelly, and child Jack, Old Joe at the Cowpen,
Long Joe and wife Sarah & child Amy, Syrus and wife Murreah
and Dinah a new Girl, Scipio and his wife Lindah, Governor &
his wife Doll, Whitehead Billy and young that was bought with him
Cooper Toney and wife Dido and their children Little Toney,
Billy, Reuby, and Dido, Old Peter and his wife Venus, and their
children. Tottemore Pariah, Beck & Silvy Corander a new Girl to
him and his heirs and assigns for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Son John Elliott all the Cattle &
Georges, with that mark belonging there, as was intended to him with the
Brand **F** and an **X** and the horses also with the Brand **F** and an **X**
to him and his Heirs and assigns for ever.

Item My Will is, that my Son Charles Elliott shall have the
use of the Lands herein after named, mentioned to him. The use of the
other part of the Lott in Charles Town that George Ingles now lives
enjoying the Bay and the Two low Water Lotts that joins the Lott
on the Bay, and also all the Lands that I possess at Sandy Hill
which is several Tracts, and the Lands that I bought of the Pandorvis
and their heirs, and all the Lands that I possess at Sawfest Swamp,
and also a Tract on Ashpore River, which I bought of Thomas Bulter
Executors, which is called Butters Island, all the said Lands (thence
the said Island, and also another Tract of Seven hundred acres on
Savannah River called the Pallochocolas, all the Lands that I
possess on the North side of the public Road that leads to Porters Ferry,
which is a part of Two Tracts which was laid out to my Father,
and another Tract which I bought of George Linson on the
Horse Shoe Creek, which contains with the Surplus Lands nine
hundred and odd acres, and all the Lands I possess at Stono
excepting the lands I bought of William Elliott Senr joining to the
said Tract, and one hundred acres to be taken of the land that I
bought of Ezekiah Emmons joining the above Tracts North and South
side of the Tract joining Robert McKim's Senior and fifty odd
acres that I bought of John Chapman to him and to his heirs and assigns for ever.

Item In case my son Charles Elliott die and leave no lawful heir or heirs begotten by him, then the above said lands, to be equally divided amongst my children's sons, that is John Elliott, Mary McKen and Sarah Elliott to them & their heirs and assigns for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Charles Elliott all these Negroes hereafter mentioned. Titbor and her children Rose and Maximam; Luke and his wife Catharina, Sarah and her children Phillis Jack Moll Kate and Betty, Boatman Prince and his wife Frank, and their children Jones Casgr & Biker, Old Jonas's son Pompey, and his wife Selvy and children Betty and Adam, Culbt and his three sons Little Cubit Jack & Bot, Yoreng, Ben and his wife Belinder, and children Ewary, Rusty and Johnny Abraham a Boy Hamers son, Monkey and his wife Jimmy, and their children Jubbo, Sinder Dorcas, Edee & Jeffery, Ashley, Alvir Prince's wife Daphney, Sam the Carter and his wife Amey, Old Casar and his wife Amey and their children Morris Isaac mingo John Goure Johnno Mudlong and Bellon, Guillian and his wife Murreah, Charles a new Negro man man Cuffy and his wife Titbor Carreer Samson and his wife Dinah, and their children July, June Hannah Bull & Grace, Sazel & his wife Gender and their children Isaac Jacob and Jeffery, Jim & his wife Sarah, Renty and his wife Simetor, Abno, and his wife Judy & their children Grece Ishmell, Snap, March Wintor & Judy, Leasunah and wife Betty and child Saucos, Lucius and his wife Pally, and child Pompey, Richman and his wife Lee, old Tom and wife Betty, Dick's Peter and his wife Jimmy, and children Malissa and Penah, Samto and his wife Venus, August and his wife Phillis, Black Hall and his wife Phetr, and children Pegg & Dinah, Shormaster Harry, and his wife Nippy and their children Munday Nippy and Robin, Venter and his wife and children Hannah George Little Venter and Adam, Scipio old Sampson's son, Prinds Carreer Sampson's son, Hector and his wife Mamey, Candy and his wife Jimmy, and their children Sarah Candy, Murreah and Cuffy, London Maryland & his wife Moll and their children Renty Ben and Prince, Venter at the Cooper old Cooper Samson and his wife Sophira, and their children Betty Mary Sarah, at the Cooper July and his wife Murreah, and child Prince, Auburn at the Cooper, Peter Handys son, Bess Cain and Jeffery, old Sampson's children Alger Haggas, new Girl, Hammy Cammerlaine the Tanner and wife Cor & child Stephy, Bristol, Ned, Shott, Racco & George four Boys Jupiter and wife Penah Old Jones and his wife Betty, Little Dick and his wife Florah and child Murreah, Boatman Jack Kiddey old Betty's daughter Frank a new negro Abram, a new Negro, to him & his heirs & assigns for ever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Charles Elliott all the Cattle at Sandy hill and on Bullter's Island, and all the Cattle at Bullockweaters with the Mark and Brand C and a X that were intended for that Cooper, and also all the horses carts and Tacklings, and all the household goods, and all Jonas' tools and all the plantation tools & all the Plate to him

and his heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give the use of all the lands hereafter mentioned to my Daughter Mary McKen, to be at her own Disposal to her children as she shall see proper to them and their heirs and assigns forever. A Tract of Land of One hundred acres I bought of Ezekiah Emory joining Vanderdussen as the plot appears, and the remaining part that is heretofore mentioned to my son Charles Elliott that is a hundred acres to be taken off of the Two hundred and twenty acre tract joining my son Charles, and another Tract of one hundred acres joining Vanderdussen that I bought of William Chapman and the other part of the Two hundred acre Tract joining Mr. Grimkeys and Mr. Stanyards and the publick Road. She is not to go over the Publick Road, and the Lands I bought of William Fairchild in Charles Town part of another Lot joining that I bought of Mr. Hill and Mr. Saret where the House is on and one hundred acres at Primers on Coosaohatchee and likewise the lands and the marsh that I bought of Mr. Elliott at Stone, To her and her heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary McKen, all the Cattle at Coosaohatchee with that mark and Brand T and X and all the Horses with the same, to her and her heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Mary McKen all these Negroes hereafter mentioned to her Big Dick and wife Cloe and child Sharper, and his wife Affie and child Sharper this wife Affie, and children Jacob, Sharper Manny and Doll, Cowpen Tom, his wife Pegg, Old Prymus and his wife Jonny and old Peter at the Cowpens, mustee Jack and his wife Pegg, and their child Hardley, Beef head Jack and his wife Daphney and child Jack, Old Morlon and his wife Tellico Solar Pompey and wife Rhina & child, Old Will and wife Elsie, York and his wife Cottonmore and their children Sarah and York, Johnney and his wife Tellico. Elsie's children Mingo & Sone, Frank Betty's son, Old Guiney Harry and wife Ruth, Glanders Jack and his wife Floah Manny, Old Pitus and his wife Satina and child Bob, Eshnell a young man, Sambova a new negro, Bojar a new negro, Amy and Rose two new girls, a Girl Amy Sabinah's daughter, to her and her heirs and assigns forever.

Item my will is that my Daughter Sarah Elliott shall have the use of a Tract of Land called Morris's hoke containing Three hundred and odd acres that John Hissley Plants on, and also part of a Lot I bought of Mr. Pioleau joining on Friend street, To her and her heirs and assigns forever.

Item if my Daughter Sarah Elliott dies and leaves any lawful Heir or heirs of her body, then to her Disposal to them as she shall see proper to her and her heirs and assigns forever.

Item my will is, I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Elliott, all these negroes hereafter mentioned to her, Prymus and Jonny old Jesse's sons Manny and her children Judy Farrow & Sarah Bricklayer Peter & his wife Sue and child Peter, Israel a Boy Winter John and his wife Stry and children Rhina and Sarah and his wife Betty and child Grace old Harry this wife

Bella, and Children Simon Henry, Maria, March a Boy,
 Gold Tom & his wife Florah & Children Ruthy, Hagar and
 Monday, Old Isaac, and his wife, Hagar and Children, Betty
 Glensider, and Doll, Bess a Girl Florah's Daughter, Aaron,
 Maron & Moll. Betsey's Children, Andelra a Girl, Paffon
 friend, and his wife Grace, and Affey and Die Two Girls
 Izraia and Gelia Two Girls, taken and her heirs and assigns forever.
Item my Will is that my son John Elliott and my son
 Charles and my Daughter Mary McKen shall each of them
 give unto my Daughter Sarah Elliott seven cows, seven calvers,
 to her and her heirs, and assigns for ever.

Item my Will is, that my son John Elliott and Charles Elliott
 Mary McKen and Sarah Elliott them or their heirs shall
 each of them pay unto my Grand Daughter, Mary Kellenger
 Elliott, the sum of Seven hundred Pounds when she arrives
 to the age of Eighteen, to her and the heirs of her own Body
 for ever.

Item my Will is, that my son Charles Elliott he or his heirs
 shall pay unto Mrs. Martha Booth, the sum of one hundred
 Pounds yearly, as long as she lives.

Item my Will is, that my son Charles Elliott he or his heirs
 shall give unto Jerry Fairchild, Two new negro Boys, when
 he arrives to the age of Twenty two to him and his heirs and
 assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto John Price the sum of
 Two thousand five hundred pounds that Colonel Heyrne
 owes me, to him and his heirs, and assigns for ever.

Item In case Colonel Heyrne pays me the money above
 mentioned to John Price, then out of my whole estate my
 Executors shall pay unto John Price the sum of Two thousand
 five hundred Pounds within Two years after my Death to
 him and his heirs and assigns for ever.

Item my Will is that each of my children them or their heirs
 shall pay unto my Sister Martha Ann, the sum of Ten pounds
 each of them to her for the space of Ten years if she dies before
 then to pay it to her two youngest Daughters.

Item my Will is that my son Thomas Elliotts widow Claudia
 Elliott shall have Liberty to live on the Plantation where she
 now lives during her widow hood.

Item It is my Will that the above mentioned negroes to each of
 my Children that they shall have them and their increase from the
 Date of this my last Will to them and their heirs and assigns for ever.

Item my Will is that my son Charles Elliott shall have full
 possession of whatsoever I have assigned to him in this my Will
 upon he arriving to the age of Twenty one.

Item my Will is that I give old Ben and old Hannah and
 Little Hannah, and her son John and old Betty Judy's mother
 those five negroes above mentioned is to have their liberty to go
 whenever they please in this Province.

Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my two sons
 John Elliott and Charles Elliott and my son in law

Robert McKen Jun^r to be my whole and sole Executor of this my Last Will and Testament and do hereby Revoke and Disannul all former Wills by me made and this to be my Last Will and Testament, Dated the sixth day of January one hundred thousand seven hundred and fifty eight.

In the name of God Amen I Thomas Elliott tho' very weak and sick yet of perfect mind and memory Do make this a Codicil to be annexed to my last Will and Testament, and no ways to Disannul any part of my last Will and Testament and to be executed by the same Executors of my said last Will and Testament viz:

Item I give and bequeath to my son Charles Elliott that part of a Lott of Land in Charles Town I bought of Mr. George Ingalls formerly belonging to William Elliott Jun^r to him his heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary McKen one half of a Lott of Land I bought of Samuel Pioleau to her and her heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Stanyarne the other half of that Lott of Land I bought of the above mentioned Pioleau to her & her heirs forever.

Item All those negroes which my Children John Elliott Charles Elliott Mary McKen and Sarah Stanyarne have in their possession they shall keep peaceable possession of to them their heirs and assigns forever.

Item Lastly my Will is that all other negroes which I have not made mention of shall be equally divided between my Children above mentioned and my Grand Daughter Mary Beckinger Elliott to them & their heirs & assigns forever.

Berkley County } Personally appeared William Thomson late
Indian Trader in the Cherokees, and made oath on the holy Evangelists
of almighty God That on the 22^d of this Instant, at the House
of James Beamer in Amelia Township there in a Room where
Thomas Beamer the son of the said James lay upon his Deathbed,
he the said Thomson asked the sick man, if it should please God
to take him out of the World, how he would Dispose of his Negroes
and Horses, He said he would willingly have a Will wrote,
and desired the said Thomson to write it he answered he could
not do it, by reason of Scurvy that he then had; Then the said
Thomson desired him to inform him after what manner he
intended to Dispose of his Effects, He answered, I give the Negro
man Tom to my Father, and the negro Wench Judith to my
Cousin Peggy, and Jack a negro man to my Cousin Charles; But
my Father to have the work of the said negroes during his natural
Life; and I give my Horses mares and Colts and Cattle and
all my other Effects for the use of the Family to help to maintain
them
