

In the Name of God amen I Thomas Jones of the parish of St George in Berkley County &c. Although Labouring at present under some Indispositions of Body Yet being of sound & perfect mind & memory through the mercy of God, do make & ordain this my Last Will & Testament in manner & form following.

First & principally I resign my Soul with the utmost Humility into the hands of Almighty God my Creator humbly hoping for a Blessed Immortality through the merits & mediation of my Beloved Saviour & redeemer Jesus Christ & my Body I desire may be buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereinafter Named I Give & Bequeath unto my Six Sons vizt Joseph Thomas James John Evans & Tobias Jones the plantation or Tract of Land wherein I Now live Containing one Thousand acres to be Equally divided amongst them to them & their Heirs forever. Item, I also Give & Bequeath unto my Loving Son Joseph one Horse named Boston to him & his Heirs forever. Item my Will is that a negro ~~Man~~ Woman shall be bought by my Executors which I Give & Bequeath unto my Loving Niece Jane Jones as soon as She arrives to the age of Twenty One years or the day of her marriage (which shall first happen) and I also give & Bequeath unto my Well Beloved Wife Jane Jones my Loving Sons Joseph Thomas James John Evans & Tobias & my Loving Daughter Eliz^a Jones vizt two tracts of Land one of three acres at my Cowpen & one ~~one~~ of four hundred forty Eight at Lion Lion to be sold & the money Equally Divided Between them to them & their Heirs for ever.

All the rest residue & remainder of my Estate real & personal whatever & whatsoever I Give Devise & Bequeath to & amongst my well Beloved Wife Jane Jones and my Loving Sons Joseph Jones Thomas Jones James Jones John Jones Evans & Jones Tobias Jones & my Loving Daughter Eliz^a Jones to be Equally divided between them to them & their Heirs for ever My Will is also that my Estate shall be undivided & not to be Divided Divided until my Son James Jones arrives to the age of Twenty one & I do hereby revoke all other Wills by me formerly made & Declare This Only to be my Last Will & Testament And I do appoint my Well Beloved Wife Jane Jones my Loving Son Joseph Jones & my friend Thomas Singleton Executors & Executors hereof In Witness Whereof I the said Thomas Jones have hereunto Set my hand & Seal 29th day of December 1760.
