In the Name of God amen I Jonathan Russ of St Thomas
 Parish in Berkeley County in the Province of South Carolina being at this
 time of sound and disposing mind memory, Judgment & understanding do make &
 ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner & form following that is
 say, I give and Recommend my Soul into the hands of God who gave it Hoping
 through the merits of my Lord Jesus Christ to receive full pardon of all my
 sins & to inherit eternal life and my body I commit to the earth to be decently
 buried at the discretion of my Executors hereinafter named, nothing doubting
 but it will be raised again at the General Resurrection by the mighty
 power of God and touching my worldly Estate I Will Give devise and
 dispose of as follows - Imprimis It is my will & desire that all my just
 debts together with my funeral charges shall be well & truly paid out of my
 Estate within some convenient time after my Decease by my executors
 I give and bequeath unto my son John Linton Russ nineteen negro
 Slaves whose names are as follow: viz. Rander Charles, Bon Bellow Lady,
 Rucy Tom Libria, Greenwich Hannah, Mingo Sarai, Country born ~~Caro~~ Caro
 Ling, Mindon little Ben, Ned Phoebe, Anthony & Simon with the issues
 of the said Bellow Lady, Lilrig Rucy Hannah Sarai, Mindon & Phoebe
 which they may have & all my household Goods, Tools & implements and
 utensils of Husbandry & two thirds of the Stock of Cattle which are at the
 plantation where he now lives & which I lately sold to Samuel Thomas
 Esq. & also one bed and furniture & one mattress and furniture, my
 writing desk, large table & six new black chairs which are at my
 dwelling house & one case of bottles which contains nine gallons & also one
 of my canoes. Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter

Elizabeth Daniel and to her heirs & assigns forever. A Plantation on
 tract of land whereon she now lives which I purchased of Mary War-
 mock & Henry Durant situate lying & being in the parish aforesaid bounding
 eastwardly on Wandow River & twelve negro slaves named Sampson
 Lydia, Molly, Ruck, Winter, Mochow, Carolina, big Lucy, Betty, Mamron
 Reek & little Phillis with the issues of the said kids Molly big
 Lucy, Betty, Reek & Phillis which they or any of them shall hereafter
 have & also the one third of the Cattle that are on the plantation
 called Williams Gore. Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter
 Martha Wicket the plantation whereon I now live in the said parish
 containing four hundred & eighty acres be the same more or less
 to her & to her heirs & assigns forever. I likewise give unto my said
 Daughter Martha & to her assigns sixteen slaves named as follows
 to wit. Primus ^{Junior} Jenny Cloe, Clara Judy, Phillis Kate big Cloe
 & Quercia Dick, Hector & Summer with the issue of the said Jenny
 Cloe, Clara Judy, Phillis Kate big Cloe & Quercia which they shall
 hereafter have with all my stock of Cattle & Hogs which are not
 herein before bequeathed & also the press one bed & Mattress with the furniture
 and all the tools Carts, Yokes, spakirons Chais &c on the plantation
 and also one of my canoes. Item my old slave London is to
 have the privilege of living on the plantation where I now live and
 do what he can towards supporting of himself or if he shall not be
 able to do it, he shall receive maintenance from off the said plantation
 Item the residue & remainder of my Household goods not herein
 mentioned I give & bequeath to my Daughters Elizabeth Daniel
 & Martha Wicket to be equally divided between them Lastly
 I nominate constitute and appoint my said son William Hutton
 Russ & sons in law Robert Daniel & John Wicket Executors of this
 my last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly Disallow
 revoke & disavow all & every other former Wills Legacy & bequests by me
 at any time heretofore made and I do hereby ratify and confirm this
 and no other to be my last Will & Testament. being wrote on one side of
 one sheet of paper the word he being interlined. In Testimony whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the eighteenth day of November
 in the third year of the reign of George the third by the Grace of
 God over Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of
 the Faith and in the year of our Lord Christ One Thousand

Seven Hundred and Sixty two.

has bestowed upon me after all singular my just debts & funeral charges
are fully & ultimately paid & satisfied I give devise & bequeath in manner & form
following that is to say Inprimis I give & devise unto my son Hugh Anderson
my house & land on the north side of Queen street in Charles Town
in the province aforesaid which I purchased of Andrew Rutledge wherein
I now live together with the hereditaments & appurtenances thereto belonging
& also my negro fellow named Joe, To hold the same unto my said son
Hugh Anderson & his heirs & assigns forever, reserving nevertheless unto my
dearly beloved wife Ann Anderson & her assigns the use & occupation of my
said house & land & the appurtenances until my said son Hugh Anderson
do & shall attain the age of sixteen years, if she the said Ann be remain & continue
my widow. Item I give & devise unto my son James Anderson my house & land
situate on the West side of Church street in Charles Town as aforesaid which
I purchased of David Maybank, together with the hereditaments & appur-
tenances thereto belonging & also my negro man named Jasper to hold
the same unto my said son James Anderson & his heirs & assigns forever
Reserving nevertheless the yearly Rents Issues & income of the said House land &
appurtenances on the West side of Church street aforesaid for & towards
the maintenance & support of my said wife Ann & the support and
maintenance & education of my Children & family until my said
son James attains the said age of sixteen years. Item for and
towards the further support & maintenance of my said wife
