 of sound & perfect mind & memory thank be unto Almighty God for the same and willing
 to mind the mortality of my Body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die
 I do make constitute and ordain this my last Will Testament in manner & form hereafter
 mentioned. And first of all I recommend my soul unto God who gave it in hope of a joyful
 Resurrection and my Body I commit to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian
 Burial at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned, and whereas the settling
 of these worldly Goods which it has pleased God to bless me with is as follows Inprimis
 I will that all these my lawful debts with my general Charge be paid within
 convenient time after my Decease Item I give bequeath unto my Beloved wife
 Elizabeth Phillips the following slaves with their Increase, viz. Brito, Fortune,
 Pat, Parkey, Pinous, Cooper, Peter, Truitt & Skipin, Nari, Amaret and Child her, and
 Child Belender & two Children, Amy, Lelary, Debt, Fozzy, Lucy, Nelly, Peggy, Harriet
 & Binah, for and during the natural life of her my said Beloved wife, & after her decease
 the above mentioned slaves with their Increase to be equally divided my two loving
 Sisters Mary Clement & Ann Phillips to them & their heirs forever, the one residing
 in Maryland Shire & the other in Pembroke Shire Item I will that the child named
 Betty be entirely free paying each year & yearly the sum of one shilling sterling
 to the Church Wardens of Christ Church Parish if demanded Item I give &
 bequeath unto my Beloved wife aforesaid all my lands One tract of one
 hundred acres Bought of John Whiggin one of one hundred acres Bought of
 John Bennett & one of fifty acres Bought of Thomas Whiteside to gather with
 all other immovables or any part of my estate both Movable & Immoveable
 during her natural life, at at her Decease to be equally divided between
 my two sisters aforesaid to them & their heirs forever. And lastly I nominate
 & appoint my trusty friend James Allen with my Beloved Wife Elizth Phillips
 to be my Executors Executors, Revocable & Disannulling all old former & other Wills
 & Wills made or Bequeathed by me done or suffered to be done Ratifying & confirm-
 ing this & more also to be my last Will & Testament In Testimony whereof I
 have set my hand & seal this tenth day of September in the year of our Lord 1764
