In manner and form following That is to say: First & principally I commend my soul to almighty God my Creation & my body to the earth from whence it was taken to be buried in a decent Christian manner according to the discretion of my Exors hereafter named & First I Revoke Renounce Frustrate and make void all wills by me formerly made and declare and appoint This only to be my last will and Testament Imprimus I give & Bequeath to Joseph Baynard & his heirs forever Ten Negroes named as follows Viz- Pymus Adam King, James, Mally, Dace, July, Pegg, Betty, Cuff, to be delivered unto the said Joseph Baynard at the years of Twenty one - Item The rest & Remainder of my Estate I leave to my well beloved wife Mary Nake during her natural life with the plantation whereon I now live But lastly at her death, the personal part, to be equally divided by lot and not by sale between my beloved nephew John Calder & my two Nieces Barbara Trilling and Mary Ciry to them and each of them & their heirs for ever I appoint assign and constitute John Calder W^m Baynard & Joseph Baynard to be Executors of this my Last will & Testament & to act according to the Tenor of the same In Witness whereof I have set my hand & seal the day & year first above written.

And as for what Temporal Estate it hath pleased Almighty God to bless me with I give devise & Bequeath in Manner & form following. Viz- Imprimus I will that my just debts and funeral Expenses be first paid & discharged. Item my will is that my land & cattle be sold and the moneys arising from the sale thereof be applied to the payments of my just debts and the remaining part to be Equally divided among my Three youngest children Item my will is that after my just and lawful debts be paid That my negroes be Equally divided between my five children John Wm William & Elizabeth Bulling & my Daughter Susanna Bulling to whose share I do leave in Trust to my
