Thomas Sachererell of Colleton County and Province aforesaid being sick of body but of sound mind and memory by the Mercies of Almighty God but knowing the Uncertainty of this mortal life do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and Form following That is to say First and Principally I resign my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it to me hoping through the alone merits and Intercession of my Blessed Redeemer Jesus Christ to obtain Pardon and Forgiveness of all my sins, my body I commit to the Earth to be decently buried at the Discretion of my Exors hereinafter named and as touching my temporal Estate I give devise and Bequeath in manner and Form following Inprimis I will that all my just debts and funeral charges be first paid and Satisfied by the sale of any Part of my Estate Real or personal, or otherwise as my Exors shall think proper Item I give devise and Bequeath unto my Beloved and Dutiful Daughter Mary Sachererell all my Real and Personal Estate that shall remain after the payment of my just debts & funeral Expenses which I give to her my said Daughter Mary Sachererell when she shall arrive or Come to the age of Twenty one years or upon her day of Marriage and to her heirs forever Lastly I Ordain Constitute and Appoint my Friends Francis Yonge of St Pauls Parish and James Sharp of St Bartholomews Parish in the province aforesaid my sole Exors as to this my last Will and Testament Resolving and making void hereby all former & other Wills by me heretofore made declaring this & this only to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Tenth Day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred & sixty four & in the fourth year of his Majestys Reign
