

And kept at Interest on good personal or such other security as the s^d meeting and church wardens and their successors shall in their discretion think most fit & convenient and that the Interest & produce annually arising from the said sum shall be applied by the s^d meeting & church wardens & their successors towards the Relief & support of such poor infirm & aged persons living in the s^d Parish as shall appear to them to be real objects of charity & deserving of the same. Lastly I do nominate constitute and appoint the Hon^{ble} Henry Middleton & Daniel Tolake Esq^{rs} Esq^r Benjamin Haring & M^r William Saunders to be Executors of this my last will & Testament & do hereby revoke disannul and make void all other wills & Testaments by me at any time heretofore made and declare this only to be my last Will & Testament Written with my own hand and contained in two paper and a half of one a Sheet of paper In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Thirteenth day of October In the year of our Lord One Thousand seven hundred & fifty nine (1759)

Be it known unto all men by these presents that I Jos: Arden Haring had a will made for some time & duly executed Oct^r 13th 1760 & did thereby give & bequeath a certain limited part of my Estate as will most evidently appear & how the same was to be employed I do now therefore by these presents contained in this my Codicil desire signify and direct that my burying place be handsomely paid for & constantly kept in repair likewise I desire that the three Mess^{rs} Williamsons have had bands gloves stockings Buckles to have given them & their wives & children which shall be equally necessary and that this my Codicil be esteemed & judged as part of my will & Test^{mt} that all things therein contained be as faithfully performed in as fine & ample manner in every respect as if the same was done in my s^d will In Witness whereof I have set my hand

In the name of God amen I William Cleland of the Parish of Christ Church in Berkeley County and Province of South Carolina Planter being very weak in body but of sound and disposing mind & memory do make & declare this to be my last will and Testament And do hereby revoke and disannul all other And do desire to give my immortal part to Jesus my dear Redeemer of poor sinners - as is appointed in the Gospel to be saved by him alone from sin; from wrath and from Hell now and to all eternity. and my Body I commit to be buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named And as to what worldly goods it hath pleased Almighty God in his great goodness to bestow on me After all just debts (proved such & funeral charges I give & bequeath as follows Item to my dear son William Cleland all my estate both real and personal To be improved Managed & Conducted by the Executors hereinafter named according to the best of the in Judgment until he arrives at the age of Twenty and one years and in case of his decease without a lawful issue then to be equally divided amongst my sister Marg^d Saunders his children by names John James & Sabbathah Eighty five hundred pounds to be given for the use of the Independent meeting at Napaun for ever I also desire

that during my sons Minority, whilst the Reverend M^r. John Martin continued Minister of the said Independent meeting. My Eors will deliver him fifteen pounds yearly from my decease. And I do hereby constitute and appoint William Vanderhorsh Arnoldus Vanderhorsh & Sam^l Linnons Eors of this my last will and Testament Whereunto I set my hand and seal this Eighth Day of September in the year of our Lord Seventeen Hundred and Sixty. Proved before his Excellency the Governor the Thirtieth Day of April 1763 and at the same time Qualified William Vanderhorsh Eor & on the 7th of May qualified Arnoldus Vanderhorsh

In the Name of God amen I Philip Jones of St James Parish in Santee in Craven County being very sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory Thanks be to Almighty God for the same, and calling to mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die I do make & ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form as follows. And first of all I Recommend my soul to Almighty God who gave it in hopes of a joyful Resurrection and my body to the grave to be buried in a decent christian Burial at the discretion of my Eors hereafter named, and now as to the settling of those worldly goods which it has pleased God to bless me with in as follows, and first of all I will that all those my lawful debts with my funeral Charges be paid by my Eors within convenient time after my decease, Item I give and Bequeath unto my beloved Wife Mary Jones, One negro fellow named Pompey and all the household goods of what kind soever. Inprimis I will that the negro wench named Dinah be sold and the money thereof put to Interest, to be equally divided between my beloved Children Mary & William Jones at the age of Twenty one years but in case either of the said Children should die the funeral charges are to be paid thereout & the Remainder comes to the Survivor of them, but in case that both should die the said money at Interest shall return to my beloved wife Mary Jones as aforesaid but in case of her Death and their survival that then the negro fellow named Pompey as aforesaid with all the household goods the money at Interest arising from the price of the negro wench sold that they shall all return to the surviving heirs of the body of her my said beloved wife Mary Jones as my Executrix and my trusty Friends William Hill & Daniel Megregor as my Eors Revoking & Disannulling all other old & former Will or Wills Deed or Deeds Jointures or Dowries or Bequests before by me made done or caused to be done Ratifying & Confirming this & none other but this to be my last will & Testament and in Witness Whereof I have set my hand and affixed my Seal this Eleventh Day of July in the year of our Lord 1761
