 considering the shortness and uncertainty of this life & that it is appointed for all men  
 once to die & being desirous to settle things in order do make publick & Avow this  
 as my last Will & Testament in manner & form following And first and  
 principally when it shall please God to call upon me by Death I Commit my  
 soul to his Almighty Protection Hoping for the Remission of my sins thro' the merits  
 of my Saviour Jesus Christ & my Body I Bequitt to the Earth to be decently buried  
 at the discretion of my Executors & Exors hereinafter named And as to what  
 Worldly Estate it hath pleased God to bestow upon me I do give & Dispose of the same  
 in manner & form following that is to say In the first place I Order & Direct  
 that my just & Lawful Debts & General Charges be first paid & satisfied Item I give  
 & Bequeath unto my beloved wife Martha Lloyd all my Household Furniture & plate  
 of whatever kind or denomination the same be And also one negro man slave named  
 Hector To hold to her & her Exors Administrators & Assigns forever Item I give & Bequeath  
 unto my Daughter Sarah my negro girl named Silvia To hold to her & her Exors Admors &  
 Assigns forever Item I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth my negro Girl  
 named Hannah To hold to her & her Exors Admors Assigns forever Item I give & Bequeath  
 unto my Daughter Susannah my negro girl named Phillis To hold to her & her Exors  
 Admors & Assigns forever Item I give & Bequeath unto my son John a negro Boy  
 named Jumbo To hold to him & his Exors Admors & Assigns forever Thus as to all the rest  
 & Residue of my Estate as well real as personal It is my Will that the same be sold  
 & disposed of by my Exors hereinafter named or to such of them as shall take upon  
 them the Burden & Execution of this my Will for the most money that can be had  
 & obtained for the same & the moneys arising from such sale I hereby Give & Order  
 to be among my said children Sarah Lloyd, Elizabeth Lloyd, Susannah Lloyd & John Lloyd  
 to be equally divided between & among them share & share alike And lastly I hereby  
 nominate constitute & Appoint my beloved wife Martha Executrix & my  
 Friends Hopson Price & John Scott of Charlestown merchant Executors of this  
 my will Hopson Price & John Scott making void all other Wills by me heretofore  
 made In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this fifth day of  
 September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & sixty one  
 Signed Sealed Published & Declared by the  
 Testator as & for his last Will & Testament  
 in the presence of us who before him at  
 his request have set our names as witnesses
