

Executors to sell and dispose of all my Estate both real and personal to the best advantage and to divide the Money thence arising into seven equal parts or shares two of which seven equal parts or shares I give and Bequeath unto my loving wife Susannah Rivers in Compensation or lieu of her Thirde and dinner and the other six parts or shares I give and Bequeath to my six children That is to say one part to my son Thomas Rivers one part to my son George Rivers one part to my son William Rivers one part to my son John Rivers one part to my daughter Ruth Stone and one part to my Daughter Susannah Rivers and the money to be paid to each Child on good personal security by my Executors and to be paid to each child when they attain the respective ages the age of Twenty one years and the girls at the age of eighteen years on the day of marriage but if any of my children should die before they attain the said ages or day of Marriage as aforesaid then the part or share pertaining to the said child or children shall be Equally divided among my surviving children share and share alike and my will and desire further is that my wife Susannah Rivers shall live on my plantation as aforesaid provided she doth not marry during the term of her natural life or till my youngest child comes of age or marry as aforesaid at which time if it tis her request the said plantation may be sold by my Executors and the money divided as before directed Then thence it is my will and desire that each child shall receive their respective share of my personal Estate as they shall attain to the ages above said and that the same be divided and delivered to them by my Executors in such manner as they in their discretion shall think proper and I do hereby nominate and appoint my two loving sons Thomas Rivers and George Rivers together with my son in law Benjamin Stone and my trusty friends

God and as touching such worldly Estate wherewithal I hath
pleased God to bless me in this life after all my just debts and
funeral charges are paid I give devise and dispose of the

 one Riding chair and two horses by name bay Jack

 during her natural life and after her death, the said
 four Negroe are to return to my Estate for the uses of my
 Children and she my wife Elizabeth to live on the plantation
 and in the house I now live in during her widowhood
 in lieu of her Dower or her power of thirds Then I give
 and bequeath unto my loving son James Miles one
 Plantation or tract of land containing four hundred
 and Thirty acres lying and being on Back kitchen Branch
 in St Bartholomew Parish in Colleton County Rusting
 & bounding southerly on land laid out unto Mr Joseph
 Bragg to the Northwest on my Brother Thomas Miles
 deceased Land to him and to his Heirs and Assigns
 forever Item I give and bequeath unto my loving
 son Robert Miles Two plantations or Tracts of land
 the one whereon I now live Containing three hundred
 acres more or less in St Pauls Parish in Colleton County
 bounding to the East on my Brother Thomas Miles deceased
 Land on the west on my Brother Elias Miles Land
 southerly on Mr Daniels Rawlings Land the other
 tract containing one hundred and Sixty two acres
 lying in the same land in the said parish butting
 and bounding to the East on my Brother Thomas Miles's
 Land to the West on Brother Elias Miles Land
 and North on the road that leads from Stono to
 Parker's Ferry to Sum and his Heirs and Assigns
 for ever. Item I give and bequeath unto my loving
 daughter Elizabeth Miles five hundred pounds Current
 money of this province to be paid to her when she comes of
 age

age or the day of marriage which may happen first to her her Heirs
 and Assigns further Item I give and bequeath unto my
 three children James Robert & Elizabeth Miles all my Personal
 Estate not set by me given or what name or denominations it
 may be off and to be equally divided amongst them so they come
 of age to them and to their Heirs and Assigns for ever. Lastly
 I do nominate and Appoint my loving brothers John Miles
 Robert Mackewn and my nephew Jeremiah Miles John Miles
 Junr and Isaac McPerson to be my Executors of this my Last
 Will and Testament & to make all former wills & testaments &
 Wishes whiche I have herunto set my hand and seal the day
 and year above written.

God therefore calling to mind the mortality of my body
and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to
die do make and ordain this my last Will and
Testament that is to say principally and first of all
I give and recommend my soul into the hands of God
that gave it and my body to the Earth to be buried in
decency and Christian burial at the discretion of my
Executor and Executrix hereafter named Nothing
doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall
receive the same again by the mighty power of God
In the next place I下令 will and appoint that
all such debts and sums of money which I shall
owe at the time of my decease as also my funeral charges
be first paid and discharged and paid the settling the
Temporal Estate which it hath pleased God to bless
me with I give and devise in manner and forme
following Imprimis I give and bequeath to my son

Black River containing four hundred and thirty acres botting
and

and bounding to the South east on lands of John Story and
on all other sides on lands not laid out also two young
negroe men and one negroe boy one large kittle, one feather
bed and furniture one large bottile case and my black
Barrett pistol, to him and his heirs forever to be delivered
to him by my Executrix and Executors immediately after
my decease Item I give and bequeath to my son John
Potts all that plantation or tract of land wheror I now
dwell Containing five hundred acres also one other plantation
or tract of land containing two hundred acres by me
purchased of Joseph Parker also one other tract of land containing
eighty acres purchased of William Brackinton also
one tract of land in Williamsburgh Township containing
two hundred and seventy acres botting and bounding
on all sides on Dacau^r Land together with the appurtenances
pertaining or belonging to each and every of the
said tracts of land also two young negroe men, and one
negroe boy one feather bed and furniture and one small
bottile case to him and his heirs forever to be delivered
to my said son John Potts where he shall arrive or attain
to the age of twenty years Item I give and bequeath
to my daughter Mary Potts one negroe woman named
Nelly to her and her Heirs forever Item I give and bequeath
to my daughter Jane Potts one negroe girl named Annie
to her and her Heirs forever, also two hundred pounds Curreny
to be paid to her within twelve months after my decease
Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Swinton
and to the Heirs of her Body lawfully begotten one
negroe woman named Cate and one negroe girl named
Charity Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Margaret
Potts one negroe girl also two hundred pounds Curreny
to her and her Heirs forever (the money to be paid within
twelve months after my decease) Item I give and bequeath
to my Grandson Thomas Johnston one negroe girl named
Annick and one negroe boy named Abraham to be delivered
to him
