seven hundred & seventy One, make & publish this my

Item I give & bequeath to my Son Samuel Stiles the sum
of ten Shillings Currency to him & his heirs forever
Item I give & bequeath to my loving Price Sarah Harden
all my wearing Apparel, Item I give to my Loving Niece
Jane Reid One feather bed Bolster & pillows & the one half
of what I have left of my Estate to her & her heirs forever
& the other half of my Estate I give to my Nephew William
Harden Jun^r to him & his heirs for ever And I do No-
minate & appoint my friends William Harden & William
Ferguson Jun^r my Whole & Sole Executors of this my last
Will & Testament & further it is my desire that my Executors
shall have full power to act in my behalf for the Estate of
Robert Reid, In witness whereof I the said Ann Stiles
have set my hand & Seal to this my last will & testament the
day & year above written
