 to my Executor or Executors, Four hundred Shards, Also I give and Bequeath
 unto my Grandson George Gilbre Logan my Negro Boy Accules, to my
 Grandson John Logan my Negro Boy Sam, & to my Grand Daughter
 Catherine Logan my Negro Girl Mary and her Issue. Also I give
 Devise and Bequeath unto Mr. Charles Elliott, his Heirs, Executors, Assigns
 and Assigns for ever, all and singular the Test Tenure and Remainder of
 my Estate Real and Personal whatsoever and where never, upon this
 special Trust and Confidence Nevertheless howsoever after mentioned, and to be
 for no other Use Intent or Purpose, that is to say in Trust, and to be the
 sole and separate Use Benefit & Behoof of my Daughter Elizabeth Logan,
 present or any future Husband during her life, and from & immorally
 after her Decease as to one Moiety or half part of my said Estate in Trust
 and to be for the Use and Behoof of such Son & Sons in such manner
 Terms, Shares & Proportions as the by my Dea Executors or Assigns of these
 Witnesses, shall at any time whether it be or may be limited, directed or appointed
 the same, and for want of such Direction Limitation or Appointment, in
 Trust & to be for the use of the Issue of the said Elizabeth Logan, who may

 forever. And as to the other Moety of my said Estate, the Trust & Profit thereof
 the and Behoof of such her Issue, their Heirs Executors, Adminors and
 Assigns forever. But in Case my said Daughter, and all the Children

 & my said Daughter Elizabeth Logan Executrix of this Will, hereby
