 Conrad Holman of St Matthews Parish Berkeley County
 & province of South Carolina being of sound & perfect mind
 & memory, praise be therefore given to almighty God, do make
 & ordain this my present last will & testament in manner
 & form following that is to say first & principally I commend
 my Soul into the hands of Almighty God Hoping through
 the Merits Death & Passion of my Saviour Jesus Christ to
 have full & free pardon & forgiveness of all my Sins & to in-
 herit everlasting life & my body I commit to the earth to be
 decently buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter
 named & as touching the Disposal of all such temporal
 estate as it hath pleased Almighty God to bestow upon me
 I give & dispose of as followeth, First I will that my debts
 & funeral Charges shall be paid & discharged, Secondly I
 give & bequeath to my Daughter from my first Wife which
 is left in Germany One hundred pound South Carolina
 Currency which shall be paid to her to any time in the space
 of ten Years after my Death, if she calls for these hundred
 pounds Currency, but if she not in the said ten years calls for
 this hundred pound she shall afterward remain by my estate
 unpaid to her & I desire my executors to notify this in a letter
 to my Daughter in Germany. Thirdly from all my
 estate both real & personal that is afterward left, I give &
 bequeath to my dear Wife Mary Ann the third part,
 fourthly from all my estate both real & personal the
 two other parts which are afterward left, I give & bequeath
 to my Children (I mean those Children that resides with us
 & were born from my wife Marian Holman in this province
 since our Immigration here) to be equally divided & distributed
 among them from which Distribution, is my eldest daughter
 Marian which is married to Mr James Kennedy not ex-
 cluded but so that my executors after named shall take an
 account from all what she hath received from my estate

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in equalling her with my other Children & my executors shall
make the Distribution in such way & manner & at such time or
times as it them shall seem proper & convenient for the benefit &
advantage of the whole. Lastly I make constitute, ordain, no-
minate & appoint my dear wife Marian Holman & Mr
Caspar Brown of St Matthews parish in this province as
sole Executors of this my last will & testament, And I do
hereby revoke & disannull and utterly disallow all every for-
mer Wills & testaments by me before this time made; Ratifying
& Confirming this & no other to be my last will & testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal, the
