Rev. Mr. Robert Cooper to purchase him a Ring as a mark of my friendly regard
and gratitude for his Trouble to whom I also give and Bequeath my share in the said Li-
rary Society and in case my said Wife should not be living at the time of my decease
then bequeath the overplus of my Estate and Effects to the said Robert Cooper whom
I hereby Nominate and Appoint Executor of this my Will as Witness my Hand this
Twenty Ninth day of December One thousand seven hundred and Seventy.
