said Wife should e marry then the said negroes are to go to my three youngest Children
them and their Increase to be equally divided that is to say to William John and
Mary Crosby, Item I give and Bequeath to my son Richard Crosby Three hun-
dred Acres of Land lying at the mouth of Sandy River in Craven County and one
hundred pounds Currency, Item I give and Bequeath to my son Thomas
Crosby Three hundred Acres of Land whereon he now lives being the One moiety
or half of the aforesaid Tract of Land that was Bequeathed to Richard Crosby, and
Likewise One hundred pounds Currency, Item I give and Bequeath to my Daugh-
ter Lydia Dove One hundred pounds Currency, Item I give and Bequeath to my son
William Crosby One hundred and fifty pounds Currency as also one hundred and fifty
acres of Land where I now live after my Wife's decease, Item I give and Bequeath to my
son John Crosby One hundred and fifty acres of Land lying on Broad River adjoining
of Thomas Hughes Land and also one hundred and fifty pounds Currency, Item
I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Mary Crosby one hundred and fifty pounds

The Twenty Fifth Day of October, in the Fourth Year of the Reign of His Majesty King George The Third; and in the year of our Lord Christ One Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty Three I David Stoll, of Charles Town, in the Province of South Carolina, Black-Smith; being (Pleased be God) in health of Body, and of sound mind disposing Mind and Memory Do make and declare this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following. Principally being truly Penitent for all my Sins, and humbly asking Pardon and Forgiveness of them, I Commend my immortal Spirit into the Hands of my Great and thro' Jesus Christ my Saviour and Redeemer; And my Body, at Death, I commit to the grave, to be decently interred, at the discretion of my Executors and Executors herein after named. Item, I will and desire that all my Debts and Funeral Expenses shall be duly paid and discharged with all convenient Expedition after my decease. Item, I Give and Bequeath unto my dearly beloved Wife, Rebecca Stoll, on the Terms and Conditions here in after mentioned concerning her, and not otherwise; All and Singular my Household and Kitchen-Furniture. Item All the Rest, Surplus and Residue of my Personal Estate, and all my Real Estate whatsoever and wheresoever, I Give, devise and Bequeath unto my Executors and Executors herein after named, or such of them as shall take upon themselves the Burden and Execution of this my last Will and Testament, and the Survivors and Survivor of them, his or her Executors or Administrators upon the several Trusts
