 I Francis Boogs being sick and Weak in Body
 and of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God therefore calling to mind the shortness
 of my life and knowing it is appointed for all men to die do make and Ordain this my
 last Will and Testament. That is to say Principally and first of all I Give and Recommend my soul
 the Hands of Almighty God, that gave it and my Body I Recommend to the Earth to be Buried
 decent Christian Burial at the Discretion of my Executors, nothing doubting at the general
 resurrection I shall receive the same again by the Mighty Power of God, and as Touching my
 worldly Estate which has blessed God to bless me with in this life I Give devise and
 dispose of the same in the following manner and form, That is to say after my Just debts
 paid and funeral Charges satisfied, I Impower I Give an Bequeath to my Loving
 Mary Hamilton the Sum of Ten pounds currency of this Province, I Give and Bequeath
 to my Loving Sister Jane Bates the Sum of One Hundred pounds currency to be raised
 out of my Estate and to be paid to her or the Heirs of her Body, I Give and Bequeath
 to my Loving Sister Sarah Lambright the Sum of Ten pound currency of this Province, I
 also Give and Bequeath to my Loving Sister Rebecca Hoyt all the remaining part of my
 Estate both Real and Personal all and singular my Lands Mesuages and Tenements and
 power by her freely to be disposed and Enjoyed, I Give it is my Will that in case I should
 die and it should please God to bless me with an Heir, then this Will to be of none Effect
 All I have made and bequeath to David Root of Johns Island and
 Province of Maryland to be sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament, And
 I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all and every other former Testament
 Wills legacies Bequests and Executors by me in any ways before mentioned Willed and
 bequeathed Ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testa-
 ment. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and
 year above written.

 hair of the Buckles I also Give unto my well beloved children after my lawful and
 Just debts are paid the Remainder of my Estate to be equally divided three Names
 follows Frederick, Jacob Margaret and one yet unborn, And I hereby utterly dis-
 annul, revoke and disannul all and every other former Testament Ratifying and confirm-
 ing this and no other to be my last Will and Testament, I also Recommend my well beloved
 Friends Mr. Philip Menden and Jacob Warner and Jones Beard and Mr. Paul
 Hemel, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and seal this day of
 the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy one and in the
 year of his Majesty King George the Third
