me at any time heretofore made and declaring this only to be my
last Will and Testament contained on this and the two preceding
Pages of one Sheet of Demi Royal Paper In Witness whereof I the
said Thomas Lind have to this my last Will and Testament set
my Hand and Seal this Twenty Eighth day of October in the Year
of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy one and in
the Twelfth Year of his Majestys Reign..

son and my Niece Ann Layton Give full Power an Authority to

any one of my acting Executors as they may act from time to time to sell
and dispose of any of my Real Estate to wards the Paying of my debts
or to the advantage of my Wife and Daughter And my will is that
my acting Executors here in after Named divide my said Real and
Personal Estate agreeable To this my last Will in some convenient
time after my Decease And I do hereby nominate Ordain and ap-
point my Cousin Benjamin Marion and my Wife Elizabeth Execu-
tors of this my last Will and Testament and if they die or refuse to
act then my Brother Peter Videau Executor thereof And if all three
die or Refuse to act then my Brother Henry Videau Executor
and I do here by revoke and make void all former and other -
Wills by me here tofore made and Publish and declare this
Present to be and contain my only last will and Testament and
in Witness whereof I have here unto Set my hand and Seal this
Fourth day of February and in the year of our Lord one thousand
Seven Hundred and Sixty Eight, This one Sheet were Signed
