In the Name of God Amen, I George Hogg of the Province of South
 Carolina in the County of Granville and parish of St. Lukes thanking all
 mighty God for his many mercies to me his unworthy Creature and in particular
 that my Natural Body is weakened by Sickness, Yet He hath pleased not to
 diminish the force of my Understanding and memory, do make this my last Will and
 Testament I assign my Soul unto the Creator in all humble hopes of its happiness through
 the mediation of my blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ as to my body it is my
 Will it be decently buried with out pomp or ostentation trusting it shall
 move alive and see its Creator and with regard to my worldly Goods which
 I have pleased all mighty God to bless me with all I give and bequeath unto
 my beloved Son John Hogg all and every part of my Estate both Present

and personal except much part as shall hereafter be Excepted and given elsewhere
to him and his heirs forever with this proviso that he may survive John Hogg
live untill he arrives to the Age of twenty one Years, but should my Son marry
before he arrives unto the age of twenty one Years, then I give and bequeath the
whole and every part to him and his heirs forever but should my said Son neither
marry neither arrive to the age of twenty one Years, then I give and bequeath
it in manner and form following. I give and bequeath unto my beloved Brother
Andrew Hogg my Tract of Land known by the name of Rattlesnake neck
containing four hundred Acres, Item I give and bequeath unto John Cole Sen.
one Negro man named Libiah, to him and his heirs forever. Item I give and
bequeath unto M^{rs} Margaret Hogg, one Negro Man named Redriff
to her and her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto Thomas Webb
one Negro Man named Dinah to him and his heirs forever. Item I give
and bequeath the rest and remainder of my Negroes not yet mentioned
to be equally divided between my three Brothers named William Hogg
Andrew Hogg and James Hogg to be equally divided among them by my
Executors hereafter named. Item I give and bequeath unto my Sister
the remainder of my Cattle that may be left upon the Plantation to be
equally divided between them to them and their heirs forever. Item
I give and bequeath unto my beloved brother William Hogg all and every part
of my wearing Apparel and it is my will and desire that my Executors
deliver them unto him immediately after my Decease, it is my Will
and desire that my Executors herein named do sell all and every parcel
part of my Estate that they shall of their wisdom see fitt and pay my
lawfull debts in soon as may be, I do hereby Revoke and make void all
other Wills by me made and do declare this to be my last will and
Testament and it is my Will and desire and I do constitute and ap-
point my beloved Friends Messrs. John Cole Sen. and John Seab by my
Executors to this my last will and Testament.
