 Time after my Decease and the money arising from the sale
 thereof shall be Equally divided between my Daughters Mary
 Maples Sarah Spier and Elizabeth of her part or in case of their
 Death to their Heirs. And Lastly I do hereby nominate
 Ordain my said Son William Sanders and friend Wood Jun-
 ior to be Executors of this my Last Will and Testa-
 ment and I do hereby utterly Disallow Repulse and disannul
 all and every former and other Wills Gifts Legacies and
 Bequests by me at any Time heretofore made Ratifying

and confirming this and as other to be my last Will and Testament In Testimony whereof have hereunto set my Hand and Seal the Twentieth Day of March in the Year of our Lord Christ One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy One and in the Eleventh Year of his Majesty's Reigner.
