In the name of God Amen I Jacob Nicholas Schwartzkopff of Charles town in the province of South Carolina practitioner in physic being sick & Weak in Body but of Sound & disposing Mind Memory & Understanding do now make & publish my last will & testament of & Concerning the worldly estate whereunto it hath pleased God to bless me which after all & Singular my just Dotts & funeral Expenses are fully & ultimately paid & satisfied, I do hereby Give devise & bequeath in manner & form following (that is to say) I give & bequeath unto George Ernst Hahnbaum of Charles Town aforesaid practitioner in physic All & Singular my books, Also my instruments & their implements & Medicines of every species & denomination & also my Gun & Sword, Item I Give & bequeath unto my God Daughter Dorothy Hahnbaum a Negro Girl named Sally together with her future Issue & increase but in case she my said God daughter shall happen to die before she attains the Age of twenty One years then it is my Will & I do hereby give & bequeath the said Negro Girl together with her future Issue & increase unto George Frederick Hahnbaum son of the said George Ernst Hahnbaum fully & absolutely for ever Item I Give & bequeath unto Christian Hahnbaum son of the late Reverend John Siroon Hahnbaum all my wearing apparel of every Species & Denomination, Item all the rest residue & surplus of my Estate real & personal whatsoever & where ever, I Give devise & bequeath unto my loving wife Mary Magdalen Schwartzkopff to her & her heirs & assigns forever Lastly I do nominate & appoint her my said wife sole Executrix of this my last will & testament revoking by these

Presents all former & other wills by me at any time heretofore made
& Declaring this only to be my last will & testament, In witness
whereof I Hermann Jacob Nicolas Schwartzkopf have hereunto
set my hand & seal this sixteenth day of April in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & seventy two & in the
twelfth year of his majesty George

& bequeath to my loving daughters Elizabeth & Sarah Mist all my
Negroes that I now possess to be equally divided betwixt them & in
Case either of them should die without leaving Issue then the
whole to go to the Survivor & if both to die without leaving Issue
to go to my loving brother John Mists Children, Also my will
is that all my Stock of Horses & Cattle be sold by my Executors -
Also that my household furniture be kept for the use of my
two Children & an equal Dividend be made betwixt them, Also
I give & bequeath to my loving Brother John Mist all my wearing
Apparel my Watch & new Gun, Also my will is that my said
Children may have their parts of my above mentioned estate when
they arrive to Lawfull Age or are married which happens first
