tained out of the Interest of her share and at the age of Eighteen she shall Inherit
her share I do hereby nominate and constitute and appoint my Friends the
John Scott Merch. and Mr. William Scott Esq. and my beloved wife Eliza-
beth Fowler to be my Executors of this my last Will and Testament In witness
whereof James Fowler have set my Hand and seal April 23rd 1767.
