or more Indifferent Persons nominated by them or by the survivor  
or survivors of them for that purpose which Division certified  
under their hands & Seals shall be for ever conclusive & binding upon  
every person whatsoever claiming or that may claim by from our-  
selves by virtue of this my last will & testament or otherwise.

Lastly I do hereby nominate Constitute & Appoint my sister Margaret  
Ridgill Executrix & my friends Job Rothmaler & William  
Ridgill Executors of this my last Will & Testament hereby re-  
voking all former Wills by me made & declaring this only to be  
my last will & testament, In witness whereof I the said Samuel  
Grier have hereunto set my hand & Seal this Eleventh day of  
June Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred & Sixty nine

the alone Merit of Jesus Christ my Saviour of my body to  
the Earth to be decently buried at the Discretion of my

Executors, Secondly my will & Desire is that my Coop now on  
 hand be disposed of by son in Law William Nreen toward  
 paying any just & Lawfull Debts & if the same are not suf-  
 ficient to discharge them that my Negroes be kept together  
 until they are discharged, then I give & bequeath to my  
 Daughter Elizabeth Nreen One Negro Fellow named Anthony  
 & all my weaing Apparel & one Riding Saddle which I am  
 to have from the Estate of my husband Charles Lewis gone  
 to work to her & her lawfull heirs to her & their own p[er]serue & be-  
 hoof forever, Item I give & bequeath to my Son Charles  
 Lewis One Shilling Sterling, Item I give & bequeath to my  
 Daughter Martha Dwight Twenty five pound current  
 money of this province, Item I give & bequeath to daughter  
 Rebekah Dwight Twenty five pounds current Money of  
 this province, Item I give & bequeath to Son William Henry  
 Lewis, One Negro named Sarah & one Negro name Lazette  
 & one other small Yellow Negro Girl Named Judy & twelve  
 Pewter plates & those Dishes & six tea Spoons & Sons of Silver  
 given case my said Son William Henry Lewis should die with-  
 out Lawfull Heirs of his body then the said Negroes gather  
 Mentioned Articles with three Stone Jugs & one large hair  
 Ring which I also bequeath to him shall be forthwith given  
 to my Daughter Elizabeth Nreen & her heirs & assigns for ever,  
 Item I give & bequeath to my said Daughter Elizabeth Nreen  
 two Stone Jugs & one Low Chair & Arm Chair & two brass  
 Candlesticks, Item I nominate & appoint my true & trusty  
 friends William Nreen Son of Josiah Allston Esq & William  
 Paisley my Executors to this my last will & testament & expect  
 they will execute the same I also acknowledge this to be my  
 last will & testament of my will & Desire is also that Josiah  
 Allston should Act as Guardian for my Son William Henry  
 Lewis In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal
