In the Name of God Amen I Jeremiah Lamar of the County of Granville and Province of South Carolina, being very sick and weak of Body, but of perfect Mind and Memory, Thanks be given unto God, calling unto Mind the Mortality of the Body, & knowing that is appointed once for all Men to die, do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament, that is to say Principally and first of all I give & recommend my Soul, into the hands of Almighty God that gave it me, and my Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian Burial, at the Discretion of my Executors, nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same by the mighty Power of God - And as touching my worldly Estate, whereunto it has been pleased God to bless me in this Life, I give Devise and Dispose of in following manner and form. First I give and Bequeath to Sarah my dearly beloved Wife one Negro Girl named Cate, all my Horses, and all my Cattle, and all my Hogs, and all my Household Furniture, Beds and all Appurtenances hereto, & to my Children being four in Number viz: John Lamar, Thos. Lamar,

Rachel Lamar and Lewis Lamar I give and Bequeath my Land being Two Hundred Acres, and a Negro Boy and Negro Girl named Will and Chlo to be equally divided when they arrive at a full age. I also Constitute and Ordain Sarah my dearly beloved Wife and Zachariah Lamar my well beloved Brothers to be the Executors of this my last Will and Testament, And I do hereby utterly and Bequeath, ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my last Will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal this Twenty second day of March, in the year of Our Lords, One Thousand seven hundred and twenty one.

In the name of God Amens I William King of Craven County, and Parish of Prince Fredericks, being in a weak and low Condition of Body, but of perfect Mind and Memory, and being about to settle my Affairs, as I may go the way of all flesh, do Constitute this my last Will and Testament, disannulling any other Will or Wills whatsoever, and in the first place I recommend my Body to the Earth, and my Soul to God that gave it, in hopes of a Glorious Resurrection, and in the first place my Will is, that I should be decently interred, at the Discretion of my Executors, and that all my Debt and funeral Charges should be paid. And Secondly I appoint and Constitute my beloved Wife Janet King, James Law, Samuel Fulton, and Gavin McAnis to be my Executors, and to see that my Will is executed agreeable to Justice. Item I give and Bequeath unto my beloved wife Janet King one Horse, Bridle and Saddle, one Bed and Furniture, and the fourth part of all my Personal Estate, and to have the privilege of my House, and Plantation during her ^{Life} Widowhood. Item I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Esther, one Horse, Bridle and Saddle, one Bed & Furniture and the remaining third part of all my Personal Estate, and after my Wife's Death a Widowhood one Hundred Acres of Land, on the upper side of my Tract, upon the Branch. Item I give & Bequeath unto my Daughter
