 Mouttrie the Use of my Negroes Named Suba Betty Phillis Judi
 for Donald Duncan and Fortune and Sarah for During the term
 of her Natural Life and after her decease I give and bequeath
 to my Son Thomas and his Heirs Suba Phillis Betty Fortune
 Sarah and Child with their future Issue and Increase And I
 also give to my Son Alexander and his Heirs Jupiter Donald and
 Duncan. I also give to my said Wife all my Household furniture
 to dispose of at her Will and pleasure and I also give her and her
 Heirs my Negro girl Nanny with her future Issue and Increase I
 also give demise and bequeath to my Son Thomas my Lands near
 Dorchester and on Johns Island to him his Heirs and Assigns
 for ever. It is also my Will that the Remainder of my Real
 and Personal Estate be equally divided between my four sons
 John William Thomas and Alexander to them their Heirs and
 Assigns for ever. I do here by Nominate and appoint my Sons
 John William Thomas and Alexander to be my Executors
 of this my last Will and Testament here by reaching all for me
 and.
