Revoking Disannulling & making void all former Wills & acknowledging this to be my last will & testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal dated this twenty third day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred & Seventy two and in the twelfth year of his one Majesty King Signed Sealed & delivered by the said William Livingston as his last will & testament

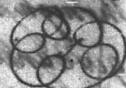

First I order all my just & Lawfull debts to be satisfied & paid. Secondly I Give & bequeath to my son John Coming Ball the following Articles Viz^t My Clock, One large Mahogany Table a Mahogany tea table One Cyprus Clothes press the Second best bed Bolster Pillow & Mattress, One pair pistols & hanger all my table linen Napkins, One Large looking Glass which hangs in the Hall & all my Kitchen furniture & pewter Thirdly I Give & bequeath to my daughter Jane Ball my China table & compleat set tea China Six Mahogany Chairs & one low Chest of drawers

which I Got from my Mother, Fourthly I Give & bequeath
 to my daughter Eleanor Ball the following Articles Viz One
 Negro Man named Jacob, One Negro Wench Pinah one other
 Wench named Violet my best bed & mahogany bedstead Curtains
 Mattress Bolster pillows Six Mahogany Chairs Sixteen Spoons
 Silver tea tongs & three Silver table Spoons, my large mahogany
 Chest of Drawers & also I Give & bequeath to my said daughter
 Eleanor Ball to be paid to her at the Age of twenty one years
 or day of Marriage which shall first happen the sum of Six
 thousand pounds currency & I order & desire my executor to
 allow my said daughter Eleanor Ball the Sum of One
 hundred pounds currency for Annua until my son
 John Coming Ball arrives to the Age of twenty One years
 Fifthly I Give & bequeath to my Son in Law Elias Ball my
 best horse & the Sum of One hundred & twenty pounds currency in
 Liew of the Black given to my Son John, Sixthly I Give & be-
 queath to my Niece Esther Roberts the Sum of two hundred pounds
 to be paid her one year after my decease, Seventhly I Give & be-
 queath all the rest & residue of my estate to my three
 Children named John Jane & Eleanor to be divided amongst them
 Share & Share alike or to the Survivor or Survivors of them that
 live to the age of twenty One Years or day of Marriage Lastly
 I nominate & appoint my Son in Law Elias Ball of Warrham
 Mr Elias Ball son of Elias Ball Esq of St Johns parish Ex-
 cutors Guardians & trustees to this my last will & to my Children
 & in case neither of them will act or they should both die before
 any all my Children should arrive to the age of intestate
 I do then nominate & appoint Mr Robert Quash
 Executor & Guardian to this my will & to my Children, In
 Witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand & Seal the third
 day of March One thousand Seven hundred & Seventy two. And
 now having settled all my temporal concerns I humbly beseech
 almighty God as he has been graciously pleased to conduct me
 thro all the vicissitudes of this life that he may in his own good

time bring me to his everlasting happiness thro' the Merits of my
ever blessed Saviour Jesus Christ Amen.
