 all the Residue of my Estate of what kind soever to be sold  
 & the Monies arising therefrom to be put out on Interest &  
 the Children aforesaid to be maintained with the Interest &  
 when arrive to the Age of twenty one or the day of Marriage  
 which shall first happen to receive an equal Dividend  
 each Child as aforesaid Mentioned & if in case the Child  
 whom my wife is big with should die or any of them then  
 the Estate to be equally divided between the surviving Child-  
 ren before they arrive to the Age of twenty one Years or the day of  
 Marriage, I constitute & appoint my loving brother John  
 Jurdine & my loving friend Thomas Westbury to be my Executors  
 Proving, Disannulling & making void all former wills
