Timber of all kinds with sundry works finished or unfinished, one three year old mare, a Brown Bay Branded on the off Buttock with a single M one Black Horse two hind feet white with a Place in the face branded with a X Crops formerly the Property of Old Mr. Wall, Item one large Team Horse formerly the property of Doctor Thomas Stinson together with a Saddle and two Bridles with all and singular of my Effects and Property, Books, Notes, Bonds and accounts, and I do hereby appoint Con- Will and Testament, And I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all and every other former Testament whatever Confirming this to be my last Will and Tes- tament, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Tenth day of September in the Eleventh year of our Sovereign Lord George the Third and in the year of our Lord God, one Thousand seven hundred seventy one.
