 blessed be God for the same do make & Ordain this my
 last will & testament in manner & form following first &
 principally I commend my Soul into the hands of
 Almighty God hoping through the satisfaction of
 Merits of my only Saviour & dear redeemer Jesus
 Christ to have full & free pardon of all my Sins & to
 inherit eternal life my body I commit into the earth
 to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors
 hereafter named touching such temporal Estate as it
 hath pleased God to bless me with I give & dispose
 thereof as followeth I improve that all my just
 Debts & funeral Charges & expences be first paid & discharged
 Item I give devise & bequeath unto my loving Son Peter
 Bochet all that plantation or tract of Land wherein I
 now live containing two hundred acres more or less also
 two different tracts adjoining the same containing two
 hundred & fifty acres which I purchased of Henry Bochet
 sometime past with a half of a tract of land of One
 hundred & fifty acres adjoining thereto which makes three
 different tracts amounting to Six hundred Acres of land
 more or less with all the buildings thereto belonging to
 him & his heirs for ever in case he attains the age of one
 twenty one years but should die before he attains to the age
 of one & twenty years as before mentioned then my will is that
 the said lands above mentioned be sold by my Executors the
 Burging place only excepted & the Money arising there-
 from be equally divided between my daughters to wit my
 Daughter Frances Mary Esther & Elizabeth or the survivors
 of them to them & their heirs for ever Item I give devise &

bequeath them to my Daughter Frances Bocket my Riding
Chair & all thereto belonging with a horse to her Election out
of my horses to her & her heirs for ever after my death I will
that the lands lately found out to be my property formerly
my Grandfather Nicholas Bocket of about two hundred acres
more or less as appears by Grants be sold by my Executors here-
after named at the highest bidding the Money arising there-
from to pay my debts as far as it will & if any more then pay
the Debts then to put it to the best advantage for the
good of the Estate, My Will also is that my executor shall
board out all my Children or bound ones out as they shall
think most proper for the good of the Estate to keep a good
Overseer on the place to clear for planting to Saw none with
out for the use of the plantation to buy Slaves as they shall
think proper for improving the Estate till my Son come
to the age of Twenty one years then the Estate be sold all
that was not before given & the money arising therefrom
be equally divided between my Children to wit my Son Peter
my Daughter Frances Mary Esther & Elizabeth Bocket or
the Survivors of them to them & their heirs for ever
But my will is if my said son should die before he attains
the Age of Twenty one years then my said Estate not be
sold before my Youngest daughter come of to the age of twenty
one year or day of Marriage then be sold as before mentioned
I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint Mr
Samuel Bocket & Mr John Singletary Executors to this
my last will & Testament hereby revoking & making null
& void all former & other wills or will heretofore made by
me & thus to stand & be my last will & Testament In
witness whereof I the said Peter Bocket have to this my

last Will & testament set my hand & seal this twenty seventh day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred & Seventy & two, My will is that a Quarter of an Acre of my land about my buying place be not sold
