

I send one Horse, Bridle & Saddle, one Bed and Furniture & the remaining second part of all my Personal Estate, and likewise my Will is that my Executors shall sell my Watch and Boots and Clothing, and that she shall have the Money, in Consideration of her Youth and Schooling, and likewise after my Wife's Death or Widowhood, she is to have other hundred Acres of Land, where my House and Plantation is. Item I give and Bequeath unto my Grandson William Frierson after my Wife's Death or Widowhood the remaining Hundred Acres of Land where his Father now lives. Item I give and Bequeath unto my Margret's Children the remaining first part of all my Personal Estate to be kept under the Care of my Executors, until the Children is sixteen Years of Age. Item I give and Bequeath to my Son John Frierson and my Daughter his Wife each of them Seven Shillings and six pence Currency. Likewise my Will is that the Estate shall not be sold, but each shall have their part by the Appraisement of indifferent Men.

Item I give and Bequeath to my sister Susannah Colleton Three Thousand Pounds Law full & Current Money of South Carolina, to be paid her by my Executors within three Years after my Death. Item I give and Bequeath to my Son Andrew Broughton my Melatto Negroe named S, during his natural Life, and after his Decease, it is my will and Desire that the said

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Males named I shall enjoy his Freedom for ever. Item I leave to my Male
Heir named Cate her freedom for ever immediately after my Death. Item
I give and Bequeath to my Sister Hannah Archer, all the residue and remainder
of my Estate both Real and Personal, to her and her Heirs for ever. In Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this Seventh day of January
in the year of Our Lords One thousand seven hundred & Sixty four.

Smith to be Executor of this my last Will and Testament, revoking all former
Wills, acknowledge this to be my last. dated at George Town this Twenty second
day of October, in the year of Our Lords One thousand & Sixty three.
