being at present sick & weak in body but of sound & disposing mind
memory & Understanding blessed be God for the same, do make pub-
lish & declare this to be & Contain my last will & testament in manner
following. First & principally when it shall please God to call me
hence I resign my Soul into his almighty protection humbly hop-
ing for the remission of my Sins thro the merits of my Saviour
Jesus Christ & my body I commit to the earth to be decently buried at

the Discretion of my Executors hereinafter named And as unto her
 worldly Estate it hath pleased God to bestow upon me for all
 & Singular my Just debts & funeral Expences are fully paid &
 satisfied, I do hereby give devise & bequeath the same as follows
 That is to say Imprimis Whereas I have agreed with the Execu-
 tors of Isaac Mazych deceased my late honoured Father for the
 purchase of a certain tract of Land Originally Granted to my said
 Father containing four hundred & fifty Acres situate on Britton's
 Neck for the price or sum of two thousand pounds Currency, it
 is my Will & I do hereby direct my Executors hereinafter named
 to pay out of any Money belonging to my Estate the said sum of
 two thousand pounds Currency to the Executors of my said deceased
 Father upon their executing good & Sufficient Titles for the
 said Land & upon the Execution of such Titles I do hereby give
 devise & bequeath the said tract of four hundred & fifty Acres of
 Land unto my Brother Paul Mazych, Also all that my
 Plantation or tract of Land which I purchased of Moses
 Britton containing four hundred & Ninety three Acres situate
 & lying on Britton's Neck in Coover County on the Northside
 of PeeDee River adjoining the above mentioned tract of four hun-
 dred & fifty Acres to hold to him the said Paul Mazych & the heir
 Male of his body lawfully begotten forever, But in case of the death
 of my said Brother Paul Mazych without Issue Male of
 his body then it is my will & I do hereby give devise & bequeath
 the said two tracts of Land with the Penditaments & appur-
 tenances thereto belonging unto the heirs male of the Bodies of my
 Brothers Isaac Mazych & William Mazych respectively as
 Tenants in Common for ever Item I give & bequeath to my Bro-
 ther Paul Mazych the sum of two hundred pounds Currency upon
 this last & Condition that he do pay the sum of twenty pounds
 Currency to Free Sylvia a Negroe Woman formerly the pro-
 perty of my deceased father Yearly & every Year during the course
 of her natural Life And upon her decease I do hereby give the said

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principal sum of two hundred pounds to the sole use & behoof of them
my brother Paul & his assigns for ever. Item I give & bequeath unto my
sister Mary Pasher the wife of Phillip Pasher of Chester town
gentleman & her assigns forever the sum of three thousand pounds
Currency. Item I give & bequeath unto my sister Mary Ann Mayzch
her assigns for ever the sum of two thousand pound currency
Item I give & bequeath unto my Brother Stephen Mayzch of his
Assigns for ever, the sum of twelve hundred & fifty pounds Currency
Item I give & bequeath unto my Nephew Isaac Mayzch son of my
Brother William Mayzch his heirs & Assigns forever all those
my three tracts of Land originally Granted to me containing respec-
tively One thousand Acres three hundred Acres & five Hundred acres
situate & being in Craven County between the waters of confluence
Rivers Also my tract of Land which I purchased of Ephraim Mit-
chell containing One Hundred Acres situate & being in St Marks
Parish Craven County Also my tract of Land which I purchased
of Moses Kirkland containing five hundred Acres situate & being
in Craven County being part of a larger tract of Land containing
Six Hundred Acres fifty acres Originally Granted to me Mr
Tucker. Also all those my three tracts of Land which I purchased
of John Mitchell containing respectively One hundred Acres
Five hundred & fifty Acres & two hundred Acres situate & being in
St Marks parish Craven County aforesaid And also all that my
plantation or tract of Land containing four hundred Acres
which I purchased of Mr Philip Pasher Together with all &
singular the Hereditaments & Appurtenances to the said se-
veral tracts of Land belonging. But in Case of the death of
my said Nephew before he attains the Age of Twenty One Years
without issue of his body Lawfully begotten then it is my will
& I do hereby give devise & bequeath All my said lands herein
abovementioned bequeathed & given him with the Heredita-
ments & appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the heirs male
of the Bodies of my Brothers Isaac Mayzch & William
Mayzch to hold to them their heirs & Assigns for ever as set-

 my Will Contrary to the Contrary thereof in any wise not.

 Acres, situated being in Amelia Township. Also all that
 my tract of Land Granted to me by the Hon: ^{Wm} Bull Esq
 Lieu Gov: of this province the twenty eighth day of January
 in the year of our lord One thousand Seven hundred &
 twenty One, containing two hundred & fifty Acres situate
 & being in Amelia Township. Also all that my tract of
 Land which I purchased of Jacob Johnson containing two
 Hundred Acres situate & being in Amelia Township afoe.
 said And also all my right & title in & to a certain tract
 or parcel of Land containing Forty seven Acres situated
 in Amelia Township for the purchase of which I have
 agreed with Morgan Sall together with all & singular
 the Hereditaments & appurtenances to the said several
 tracts of Land belonging, But in case of the Death of my
 said Nephew before he attains the age of twenty One years
 without issue of his body lawfully begotten then & in such
 case it is my Will & I do hereby give & devise & bequeath all
 my said lands herein abovementioned bequeathed him with
 the Hereditaments & Appurtenances therunto belonging
 unto the heirs male of the Bodies of my Brothers Isaac
 Mazych & William Mazych to hold to them their heirs &
 assigns for ever as tenants in Common, Item whereas Morgan
 Sall hath agreed to convey to me a certain piece of Land con-
 taining Forty Seven acres situate & being in Amelia Township
 in Lieu of thirty five Acres of Land which I purchased

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of Daniel Strobel & payment of the sum of ~~thirty five pounds~~ Curreny being the supposed rate Difference in value between the said two tracts which said sum of ~~thirty five pounds~~ I have lately paid to the said Morgan Labb, I do therefore hereby fully authorise & impower such of my Executors herein before named as shall qualify & take upon them the Execution of this my will & the Survivors & Survivor of them to make & execute good & sufficient Titles & Conveyances for Conveying & giving the said thirty five Acres of Land unto the said Morgan Labb his heirs & assigns for ever & as may by Council be advised upon condition nevertheless that the said Morgan Labb or his representatives in case of his death do carry into Execution his part of the said Agreement & do make good & sufficient Titles for the said forty seven acres of Land to my Nephew William Mazyck Jun to whom I have & do as above give bequeath & Assign all my right & titles to the same, Item I do hereby Give & bequeath unto my Nephews Isaac Mazyck & William Mazyck Jun Sons of my Brother William Mazyck & to their heirs & Assigns for ever All my plantation & other Negroe Slaves in the Country (except Joe, Boatman & Dick who yet direct be continued on the plantation at work as usual untill April next) Also my following Negroe Slaves in town via Frank Holland, Stephen & Martin & it is my Will & I do hereby direct that the Lands given & devised to my said Nephews be carefully improved from time to time & planted in common And the plantation Slaves be employed theron as usual & to the utmost advantage for their joint use & benefit & my said Nephews maintained & liberally Educated & all Taxes & other Charges on the said lands & Negroes paid out of the Issues & profits arising & accruing therefrom untill my Nephew Isaac shall attain his full age of twenty One Years & then & not before the said Negroes & other Slaves & their Increase equally divided between them share & share

alike. And in the Mean time the Clear Rents & your
 Accrues & profits arising therefrom be placed out at Interest
 or invested in the purchase of Lands Negroes or other Slaves
 as by my Executors shall be judged most conducive to the
 benefit & Advantage of my said Nephews Item I
 do hereby order & direct that my house or Messuage con-
 sisting of two tenements fronting on Broad Street &
 Bedons Alley in Charles Town aforesaid & my house
 & lot situate at the upper end of Broad Street lately
 conveyed to me by my Brother Isaac Marrych in pur-
 suance of the last Will & Testament of my late deceased
 Father be sold as soon as conveniently may be after my
 decease either at publick or private Sale as my Execu-
 tors may see fit, hereby fully authorising & empowering
 my said Executors & the Survivors & Survivor of them or
 such as shall qualify & take upon him or them the
 burden & Execution of this my Will to make & execute good
 & sufficient Title & Conveyances whatsoever on the Law
 necessary for conveying & assuring the same or any part unto
 the purchasers or purchaser thereof Item as for & concerning
 all & Singulær the rest Surplus & Residue of my Estate
 both real & personal whatsoever & wheresoever after de-
 ducting all & Singulær my Just Debts Funeral Expenses
 & pecuniary bequests herein before Mentioned & the charges
 & expences incident to the Execution of this my Will
 I do hereby give devise & bequeath the same unto my
