I hereby Constitute Nominate & appoint my Loving friend Che-
Dennis of Charles Town Merchant & my said Son William Young
Executors of this my last will & testament. In witness whereof
I the said William Young to this my last will & testament
contained in two sheets of paper set my hand & Seal that
is to say to the first Sheet thereof my hand & to this second Sheet
thereof my hand & Seal & also my Seal to the Tape which af-
fixes the same together at the Bottom this twenty seventh day
of August in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred &
Seventy one & in the Eleventh year of his majestys Reign.

In the name of God Amen, I Robert Quast, of the
Parish of St Thomas & St Dennis in Berkeley County in the province
of South Carolina Planter being of sound & disposing mind Me-
mory & Understanding blessed be god for the same but calling to
Mind the Mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed
for all men once to die do make & Ordain this my last will &
Testament in form & manner following, First I commend my Soul

into the hands of God who gave it & may bidly I Commit to the earth to be
 decently interred at the Discretion of my Executors herein after men-
 tioned nothing doubting but at the General resurrection I shall re-
 ceive the same again but the mighty power of God & as for such
 worldly Estate as it has pleased God to bless me with, I give devise
 & bequeath the same as follows, *Imprimis* I will that all my
 just debts be paid off & discharged, *Item* I give to the Vestry of
 St Thomas parish for the use of the poor of the said parish
 thirty pounds, *Item* I give to my Godson Josias Bonneau fifty
 pounds, *Item* I give & Devise & bequeath to my Son Robert Quash
 & his heirs for ever my plantation whereon I now live with its
 appurtenances containing about Seventeen hundred pounds acres
 of Land subject nevertheless to the use next immediately herein
 after mentioned viz that I give devise & bequeath to my beloved Wife
 Elizabeth during her Widowhood the joint use of my said plan-
 tation dwelling house barns & other outhouses & Conveniences
 thereto belonging together with my said Son Robert, *Item* I give
 devise & bequeath to my said Son Robert Quash & his heirs for ever
 that Plantation of One thousand & four acres or thereabouts which
 I purchased of Mrs Hannah Hasell, *Item* I give devise &
 bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Quash & her heirs for ever
 my house & lot with its appurtenances in Charles Town
 situate lying being at the West end of Broad Street & known
 in the plan of the said town by the number two hundred &
 Seventy which I purchased of Jordan Roche, John McKensie
 & Branfield Evans & I do also give & bequeath five thousand
 pound to my said Daughter Elizabeth to the intent that my
 Executors herein after named shall lay out & expend so much
 money for her in buildings to be put up on the said lot which I
 will shall be done before the remainder herein after mentioned
 of my personal Estate shall be distributed amongst my Children
 And whereas in a former will I gave & devised those lands
 I purchased of Mrs Hannah Hasell to my daughter Frances
 Susannah & her heirs & I have now given & devised them to my
 said Son Robert & his heirs, I do give & bequeath to my said
 Daughter Frances Susannah ~~Sum~~ now Frances Susannah
 the sum two thousand five hundred pounds in lieu & stead thereof

Bess Isabell, I give & bequeath to my Son Robert Quash the
following Slaves or so many of them as shall be living at my decease
& their Issue & increase from the making this my last will & testa-
ment viz Guy, George, Country born will, Buffy, Sawney, Ammon
Young Guy, Samson, Song Tom, Jacob Tony, Grippac Mack
Young Sambo, Betty & her six Children, Abigail & her three
Children, Carter & her two Children, Lory & her two Children, a
Young Wench called Phillis, I give & bequeath to my
Daughter Elizabeth Quash the following Slaves or so many
of them as shall be living at my decease their Issue & increase
from the making this my last will & testament viz Betty & her son
Amos March Cudjo, Marper, Orange Dido Joan maddong violet
Friday Nandy Dena Conny peter Lenia Tina Silvia Lydia
Hannah Jenny Nero Pool Paul, Philander Rachel, I give
& bequeath unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth & Chair &
house & also a Bed & furniture, I give & bequeath all
the rest Residue & remainder of my personal Estate what-
ever unto my said Wife Elizabeth & my said three Children

Elizabeth Quash with the intent that my Executors should erect
up the said Buildings. I do hereby declare the said sum of
five thousand pounds to be already applied by me to the use for
which it was bequeathed & in this I do hereby confirm my
bequest of the said Lot of Land at the West end of Broad Street with
the Buildings lately erected thereon to my said Daughter Elizabeth
Quash & her heirs for ever. And whereas I have given & bequeathed
to my Son Robert Quash a certain number of Slaves named in
my said will & their Issue & Increase from the making my said
will I have since that given to him the said Slaves actually & put
him in actual possession thereof. And whereas I have in my said
will given & bequeathed a horse & Chair & a bed & furniture to my
wife Elizabeth I will that a Chair & two horses at her Election & all
my plate & household furniture excepting my Clock which I give
& bequeath to my son Robert shall go to her and said wife &
I give & bequeath the same to her accordingly. Item I give & bequeath
a Negro boy called Simson to Josiah Bonneau aforementioned
Item I give & bequeath a Negro Girl called Molly to my niece
Mary Bonneau Item I give & bequeath to my niece Hannah
Bonneau a Negro Girl called Blawnda. Item I give & bequeath
to my Grandson Roger Pinchney when he shall arrive at the
Age of One & twenty years the two following Negroes a boy called
Jupiter & a Girl called Jenny also another Girl called Cinah.
And I do hereby nominate & appoint my Son in Law Roger
Pinchney my wife Elizabeth & my Son Robert Quash Executors
to my last will & Testament. And I will that this Codicil
be annexed to my last will & Testament aforesaid & be taken &
considered as part & parcel of the same And in Witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this twenty fifth
Day of July & in the year of Lord one thousand seven hundred
& Seventy one
