In the name of God Amen I Samuel Grier
of Craven County in the province of Carolina Planter being in
good bodily health & of sound & disposing Mind do make & Ordain
this to be my last will & testament reserving my soul to
God & desiring that after my decease my body may be decently
Interred by any Executrix & Executors herein after named & with the
Prospect to the worldly Estate of which I may die possessed, I
will as follows, In the first place, I order that my whole Estate
wheresoever & whatsoever be kept together & improved until all my
just debts shall be paid, after which I give unto my Son John
Grier the Six following Negroes viz "Ben, Bob, Glasgow, Lydia
Sibria & Mrs. Also one fourth part of my Negro Slaves not par-
ticularly named in this my will One third part of my house-
hold Goods & Kitchen Utensils, my riding horse & watch gone half
of my Stocks of Cattle Horses Hogs & Sheep, Also give devicely
bequeath unto my said Son John & to his heirs & assigns for ever
Two thirds of that any Plantation or four tracts of Land, situate
on Great Peeche River wherein I now reside containing in the
whole nineteen hundred & fifty acres of Land more or less to be
divided as is herein after directed, also all that my plantation

a tract of land on little Peegee containing by estimation
 three hundred & fifty Acres originally laid out to William
 Promissay, And likewise all that my plantation or tract
 of land on Waccamaw containing two hundred & fifty acres more
 or less, Item I give unto Mary Ridgill, Job Rothmehler
 & William Ridgill in trust for the use of my daughter
 Elizabeth these my six Negroes named Dick, Parice, Peter
 Hannah, slate, Samney, also one fourth part of my negro
 Slaves not particularly named in this my will, one third
 part of my household Goods & Kitchen Utensils & one half of
 my Stocks of cattle Horses Hogs & Sheep, Item I give devise
 & bequeath unto my Daughter Agnes M^o Dougal wife of
 Mr John McDougall all that my Plantation or tract of
 Land on Hunting Swamp containing by estimation Seven
 hundred & Seventy five Acres more or less & to her heirs & assigns
 forever, also one fourth part of my Negro Slaves not particu-
 larly named in this my will, & likewise One third part
 of my household Goods & Kitchen Utensils, Item I give devise
 & bequeath unto my Grandson Samuel Gries son of William
 Gries deceased one third of that my plantation or four tracts of
 land situate on Great Peegee River wheron I now reside
 containing in the whole nineteen hundred & fifty Acres more
 or less & to his heirs & assigns forever to be divided as is here-
 in after dissected, Also one fourth part of my Negro Slaves
 not particularly named in this my will, Item I give devise
 & bequeath unto Agnes Jordan widow of Joseph Jordan dec^d,
 & to her heirs & assigns for ever all that my plantation or tract
 of land containing by estimation three hundred Acres joining
 the seven hundred & Twenty five acres of land on Hunting
 Swamp given to my Daughter Agnes M^o Dougal as
 abovementioned, Also one Negro Girl named Dibby & one
 Negro Boy named Sambo, Item my will witness & I do order that
 my sister Mary Ridgill with her husband shall have free
 liberty to reside on my Peegee Plantation where I now dwell

with Land to Plant them as long as she lives & shall have the
use & occupation of the Dwelling house & conveniences thereunto be-
longing until my Son John shall arrive to his age of twenty One
Years Item I do order that all the Divisions directed or intended
by this my Will, as well of my Real as of my personal Estate, shall
be made by my Executrix & Executors herein after named or by three
or more Indifferent Persons nominated by them or by the survivor
or survivors of them for that purpose which Division certified
under their hands & Seals shall be for ever conclusive & binding upon
every person whatsoever claiming or that may claim by from our-
selves by virtue of this my last will & testament or otherwise.

Lastly I do hereby nominate Constitute & Appoint my sister Margaret
Ridgill Executrix & my friends Job Rothmaler & William
Ridgill Executors of this my last Will & Testament hereby re-
voking all former Wills by me made & declaring this only to be
my last will & testament, In witness whereof I the said Samuel
Grier have hereunto set my hand & Seal this Eleventh day of
June Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred & Sixty nine
