 Issue & increase & also one plain Gold Ring & one pair of Gold
 Sleeve Buttons, Item I give & bequeath unto my daughter Mary
 Eden my two Negroes named Patience & Philis Girls with their
 future Issue & Increase for ever with all my household furniture
 of whatsoever nature or kind the same may be & my mourning
 ring & Wedding ring for ever, Item I Give & bequeath unto my
 said three Children James John & Mary all the residue of my
 Estate Real or personal to them & their heirs & Assigns forever
 And I nominate & appoint my brother Francis Gottier,
 James Gottier Eden & John Gottier Eden my Executors of this
 my last will & testament revoking all other Wills by me
 heretofore made declaring this only to be my last will &
 testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 & Seal the twenty third day of March, In the Year of our
 Lord One thousand Seven hundred & Seventy
