Item I will that my House and Land in Meeting Street where I now live be reserved

and unsold until my Youngest Child arrives of Age then the said House and
 Land to be sold to the best Advantage and the Money Arising therefrom
 to be Equally divided between my said Wife Ruth Cole and my five Children
 I give unto my Wife Ruth the furniture of one Room for ever with Liberty to live in the said
 House in the said Street until the said Youngest Child comes of Age and
 or until the same are sold as before expressed And lastly I
 do hereby nominate and appoint my Trusty Friend Thomas Llan
 Smith Esq^r and my Brother in Law William Praper to be my Execu
 tors and my Wife Ruth Cole to be my Executrix of this my Last Will and
 Testament dated at Charles Town in the Province aforesaid the twenty
 first day of October in the Twelfth year of his Majestys Reign and in the
 Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy One
