

I do will and desire that the Test and Residue of my Estate as well Real as Personal be sold as soon after my death as shall be convenient and the Money arising from the same for the payment of my Lawful Debts be put to Interest by my Executors, for the use and benefit of all my Children in equal degree and that an equal part or Portion thereof be paid to each of them as they shall arrive to the age of Twenty one years or day of Marriage which shall first happen. Item it is also my will that in case any or either of my Children should die without Issue that their part or Portion shall in that case go to the survivors as Survivors. Item It is also my will and desire that in case all my Children should die without Issue then and in that case I would have that part of my Estate go in the following manner the use of one Third thereof to my wife for and during her natural life and then to be equally divided amongst the several Children of my three Brothers Robert William and bulchith, and the other Two Thirds of my said Estate left to my Children in case of their Death without Issue I also Give and Bequeath amongst all the Children of my three Brothers that may then be alive share and share alike to them and their Heirs for ever. This is my last Will and Testament revoking all others whatsoever heretofore made signed sealed and acknowledged to be my last Will and Testament this Twenty Eighth day 28th day of November 1766.

be buried and interred in a decent and Christian like manner at the discre-
tion of my Executor herein after nominated and appointed, and to the Worldly-
Estate where with it hath pleased God in this life to bless me, I Give the same
and residue thereof as follows, I will and desire that my said Executor do with all
convenient speed pay off discharge and satisfy all and every my Just and Lawful
Debts and for that purpose do will and ordain that my said Executor shall with
all convenient speed after my decease bargain sell and alien in fee simple my Lot
of Land in Charles Town together with all and singular the Houses out Houses
Edifices Rights Members and Appurtenances upon the same being and to the
same belonging and appertaining And ALSO all and every part of my Personal
Estate except such part thereof as is herein after given and disposed of for the doing
executing and perfect finishing whereof I do by these Presents give grant will and
transfer to my said Executor and to his Executors and Administrators full Power
and Authority to alien bargain sell convey and assure the said Premises to any
person or Persons and their Heirs for ever in fee simple by all and every such
lawful Ways and Means in the Law as to my said Executor and his Executors or
Administrators shall seem fit and necessary and out of the proceeds of the said
Sale thereof and any Money

ing and to his Heirs and assigns for ever Two Hundred pounds current Money of the said
Province. Item my Horse Saddle Bridle and Gun I give and Bequeath to my Nephew
William Fickling Son of the said George Fickling and to his Heirs and assigns for
ever. Item to my Cousin Mary Fickling Daughter of the said George Fickling a
suit of Mourning. Item after payment of my said Debts and Legacies as afo-
said one fourth part (the whole into four equal parts to be divided) of the Balance
then remaining I give to the said George Fickling and his Heirs and assigns
for ever. One other fourth part thereof I give and Bequeath unto my Brother in Law
Alexander Russell and to his Heirs and assigns for ever. Item one other fourth
part I do hereby Order and direct my said Executor to put and place out at Inte-
rest for and during the Term of the Natural Life of my Sister Sarah Bradley
and the Monies arising from the Interest thereof yearly and every year to her
to pay and the same to receive to and for her own sole and separate use and bene-
fit to the Intent that the same may not be at the disposal of or subject or liable
to the controul Debts or Engagements of her said Husband. Item after the
Death of my said Sister Sarah Bradley I give and bequeath unto and amongst her
children equally to be divided between and among them share and share alike toge-
ther with all the Interest Money thereof if any shall be then due. Item the other
and last fourth part thereof I do hereby also order and direct my said Executor also
to put and place out at Interest for and during the Term of the Natural Life
of my Sister Martha Langwell and the Interest arising therefrom yearly and ev-
ery year to her to pay and the same to receive to and for her own sole and separate
use and benefit to the Intent that the same nor any part thereof may not be
at the disposal of or subject or liable to the controul Debts or Engagements
of her Husband and after her Death I give and Bequeath the same and
the Interest thereof unto my said Brother in Law the said Alexander Russell
and to his Heirs and assigns for ever. And Lastly I do hereby Nominate
constitute and appoint my said Brother in Law the said Alexander Rus-
sell Executor of this my last Will Will and Testament hereby revoking and
making void all and every Will and Wills heretofore
by me made and confirming this and this only to be my last
will. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal
this Eighth day of October in the year of our Lord, one Thousand seven
hundred and twenty and in the Tenth year of his Majesty's Reign.
