in manner and form following - that is to say First and Principally I com
mend my Immortal Soul into the Hands of Almighty God my Creator through
the merits and mediation Jesus Christ my Saviour and Redeemer and my
Body I commit to the Earth to be buried in a decent and Christian like man
ner at the Discretion of my Executors here in after mentioned and bencov
ing the Temporal Estate where with it hath please God to Bless me with
I Will and ordain that the same and every part and parcel thereof shall be
disposed of in manner and form following that is to say I Will to do and
Appoint that all my just Debts and Funeral Expences be discharged and
Paid as soon as convenient it may be done after my decease. Item I give
and Bequeath unto my dear Brother Jonathan Fabian the Plantation
or Tract of Land wherein I now live at Fort Hoodoo also Two Negroe boys
commonly known by the Names of Kit and Stevy and also a Bond that
I have against Capt John North the above Promises to him and his Heirs
and Assigns for ever more - My Will also is that the same Following
Negroes viz Harry King Primus Rose and Child George Pegg Inde with
with her Youngest Child and Household Furniture and Stock of Horse
Cattle and Hogs to be sold by my Executors here aforementioned at pub
lich Vendue and all the money arising of the Sale of the above same
Negroe Stock of Horse Cattle and Hogs &c to be Equally divided
between my loving Brothers James Fabian Joseph Fabian and more
than Fabian to them and their Heirs and Assigns for ever -

I give and Bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Ruth Page a Negro Girl commonly known by the Name of Africa the Black Daughter of a Negro called and known by the Name of India as long as this Ruth Page shall live and after Death to my Dear Brother Joseph Fabian aforesaid to him and his Heirs for ever. My will also is that all my Plantation Tools &c. should be sold at Publick Vendue and the Money arising to be equally divided between all my Brothers to them and their Heirs for ever. My Will is also that an old Fellow called an unknown by the Name of August and old Menoh called and known by the Name of Micie should at my Death have their Freedom Lastly I do hereby Nominate Constitute and appoint my said young Brothers James Fabian Joseph Fabian and Jonathan Fabian Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking and Making Null and Void all and all manner of former and other Wills or Wills by me at any Time or Times heretofore made hereby declaring this only to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I the said William Fabian to this my last Will and Testament have hereunto set my hand and Seal the Twenty fifth day of February in the Year of our Lord one thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty five.
