I Give Bequeath and dispose of in Manner and form as follows; I Give and order that all my Just debts and Funeral Charges be paid as soon as decency will admit of after my Decease. Item. I Give and Bequeath unto my Loving Son William King my Two Negro Men Jack and Scipio to him the said William King and unto his Heirs for ever. Item. I Give and Bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Elizabeth King my Negro Girl Sue and her Issue when she the said Elizabeth King shall arrive to the Age of Eighteen Years or day of Marriage which shall happen first unto her and her Heirs for ever. Item. I Give and Bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Mary King my Negro Boy April when she the said Mary King shall arrive to the Age of Eighteen Years or day of Marriage which shall happen first unto her and her Heirs for Ever Item. I Give and Bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Susannah King my Negro Boy Ephraim when she shall arrive to the Age of Eighteen Years or day of Marriage which shall happen first unto her and her Heirs for Ever. Item. Item. I Will and order my Executors to pay unto John Gantlet Cadman at the End of One Year after my decease the Sum of Fifty Pounds Currency. Item. I Will and order my Executors to pay at the End of One Year unto Sarah Ellise and Mary Spencer the Sum of twenty Pounds Currency

unto each of them. Item I will and order my Executors to pay
 at the end of one Year after my decease to Ann Cadman the sum
 of Ten pounds Currency. Item I Will and do order my Executors
 to Set my Old Negro Man Bristol at Liberty from the day of my
 decease he the said Negro Man Bristol paying the sum
 of one Pound Currency yearly and every Year to my Executors
 Item I will and do order at the End of one Year after my
 decease that the Residue and Remainder part of my Negroes
 not Mentioned Above be sold at Publick Vendue by my
 Executors and the Money's Arising from such Sales after my
 Funeral Charges Debts and Lagacies Above mentioned being
 first paid then the overplus Money if any there be I will
 and Order that it be Equally divided Amongst and be
 between my Son William King and his two Daughters Jane
 Mary Elizabeth and Susannah King Daughters of the
 Above William King Share and Share alike. Item
 my Further Will is that my Whole Estate be continued to
 gether for one Year after my death by my Executors
 Except my Old Negro Man Bristol and the Estate to be at
 the sole Management of my Son William King for the afore
 said Term of One Year and then to be divided as Directed above
 Last (V) There by Improver Constitute and Appoint Messrs.
 William Holmes Isaac Rivers and John Hearne of Jamaica
 Island Planters Executors of this my said Will Giving them
 and each of them Power to Act conduct and Manage my
 Estate above Mentioned as fully and Effectually as may
 be Necessary for them and each of them Agreeable to
 my Intentions here in Expressed and to Execute all
 and every Trust Reposed in them and each of them as
 Trustees and Executors of this my last Will and Testament
 here by Revoking all former and other Wills by me here
 Declare this to be my last Will and Testament and
 Witness whereof I have here unto Set my hand and Seal
