day of February 1764 I William Parmenter of Granville County
Planter Being very Sick & weak in Body, but of perfect
Mind & Memory thanks be given to God therefore calling to
Mind the mortality of my Body & knowing that it is appointed
for all Men once to die, Do make & Ordain this my last
Will & testament, that is to say principally & first of all, I give
& recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that
gave it & my Body I recommend to the earth to be buried in
decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors
nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall
receive the same again by the mighty power of God And as
touching such Worldly Estate as herewith it has pleased God to
Bestow on me in this life I give demise & dispose of the same

in the following Manner & form, First I give & bequeath to
 Martha my dearly beloved Wife One Riding Mare called
 Fancy & Saddle & three Cows & Calves & One Bed & furniture
 such as I've now in my Possession with such a Maintenance
 as my Estate can afford during her Widowhood, Secondly
 I will that all the rest of my Estate be kept & improved at
 the discretion of my Executors for the use of my three Chil-
 dren Jane David & Ann to be equally divided amongst them
 as they shall come to age, And in case the said three Children
 Jane David & Ann should die before they come to Age
 I will that my Estate be equally divided between my Sister
 Catherine Parmenter & my Uncle Thomas Parmenter or
 heirs, I do likewise constitute make & Ordain my loving
 friends my Uncle Thomas Parmenter & my Brother in
 Law Joseph Parmenter Executors to this my last Will
 & Testament And I do hereby utterly disavow revoke
 & disannull all & every other former testaments Wills
 Legacies & Bequeaths & Executors by me in any ways be-
 fore named Willed & bequeathed, Ratifying & confirming
 this & no other to be my last Will & testament, In witness
