South Carolina In the name of God Amen I
William Dewees of the Parish of St Philip in
the State aforesaid, Factor, do make this my Last Will
& Testament in manner following. It is my will that my
brick House and premises thereto belonging on the East
side of Alexander Street in Mazyckborough to be sold by
my Executors and Executrixes hereinafter named or such
of them as shall qualify and will act either at public
or private and on such terms as may appear most advan-
tageous for the parties interested. And I give to my
daughter Mary Dewees Five thousand Dollars out of the
monies to arise from the sale of the said House and prem-
ises. I also give to my said Daughter Mary my brown girl
named Dye and Caleb and all her future issue to be born
after the date of this my Will. Item I give to my two
Daughters Mary Dewees and Jane Dewees all my plate, house-
hold and Kitchen furniture Bedstead Bedding Bed Linen Ta-
ble Linen Carriage Cart and Horses to be used and dis-
posed of to them as they may think proper. Item I give
to my son Joseph Dewees forever my Westermost Tenement
fronting on Charlotte Street Mazyckborough and my negro
Jim and Eight hundred Dollars out of the proceeds of the
brick house and premises abovementioned. Item I give to
my Daughter Ann Hamlin forever my Easternmost tenement
and Lot in Charlotte Street Mazyckborough and my wench
Lucy and her son Joshua and all her issue to be born after
the date of this my Will. Item I give to my Baum Son
John Dewees forever my Lot and House on Mary Street now
occupied by him, formerly Reids Land as the fence now
stands. Item I give to my Daughter Sarah Postell forever
my House and Lot fronting on Alexander Street about fifty
six feet & in depth one hundred and Sixty feet, and my

of the females to be born after the date of this my
will: Item I give to my daughter Anna Dawes forever my
lot and house at the corner of Alexander and Charlotte
streets Newbernborough measuring one hundred & sixty two
feet on Alexander street and ninety feet or thereabouts
on Charlotte Street and my Negroe Harry Tom Gray and
both with the future issue of the females to be born af-
ter the date of this my will. Item I give to my grand
daughter Mary Frances Postell my negroe Bimah Sophia
grandson & Charlotte and the future issue of the females to
be born after the date of this my will. Item I give to
my grand Daughter Charlotte Smith Postell my negroe boy
John Robert her son Hannibal and Abby and the issue of
the females to be born after the date of this my will.
Item I give to my grand Son Joseph Postell my Negroe Ned
Jack Carolina and Sabrina and her issue to be born after
the date of this my will. Item I give to my three grand
children Mary Frances Postell, Charlotte Smith Postell,
and Joseph Postell my House and lot on Mary Street adjoin-
ing the one occupied by my son John Dawes, as the fence
now stands and a lot adjoining my White House fronting on
Alexander street with a small Kitchen and Stable thereon,
now occupied by Joseph Dawes, and the balance of money
if any shall remain from the sale of my brick house be-
forementioned the said House and lot on Mary street and
the said lot on Alexander street to be rented or sold by
my Executrixes & Executors as they shall think best, and
the monies to arise from the rents or interest of the same
and from the balance of money aforesaid to be vested in
bank stock for the benefit of my said three grand children
until they shall be married or come of age. Item I give
to the aforesaid Mary Frances Postell thirteen shares in
the Planters Mechanicks Bank. Item I give to my said

said daughter Charlotte Smith Postell Ten Shares in the
said Bank and to my grandson Joseph Postell Ten shares in
the said Bank, and if any of my said three grand children
shall die under age and unmarried, the property herein-
before given to them shall go to the Survivors or Survi-
vor of them and in case of the death of all of them under
age & unmarried then the same shall be equally divided
amongst all the children of my son John Dewees and my
daughter Ann Hamlin. Item I give to my son William Dewees
forever my Brick Store & Lot on Gordes Street late
Friedmans Wharf. Item I leave my Pew on the north side
of the middle aisle of Saint Philips church in Charleston
for the use of the Family. Item notwithstanding any thing
herein before contained, in case any of my Daughters
shall die leaving no child or children surviving, the real
and personal estate hereinbefore given to my said Daugh-
ters shall go to the Survivors or Survivor of my said
daughters who may then be living, and if none then liv-
ing to be equally divided amongst all my grand children
except William D Postell and Philip S Postell, and all
the rest and residue of my Estate whatsoever and where-
soever I give to my Daughter Sarah Postell during her Life
and after her death to her three youngest children Mary
Frances Postell, Charlotte Smith Postell & Joseph Postell
or the survivors or Survivor of them. Lastly I nominate
& appoint my two Sons William and John Dewees and my two
Daughters Mary and Jane Dewees Executors and Executrixes
of this my Will hereby revoking all former Wills by me
made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Seal this fifteenth day of January in the year of our Lord
one thousand Eight hundred and twenty seven.
