Raymonds of the City of Charleston being Sick and weak of body but of sound and disposing mind and memory, and deeply considering my Mortality and knowing that it is ordered and appointed for all men once to die, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs while I have strength and capacity so to do: do make and publish this my Last Will and Testament hereby revoking and making void all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made First and principally I commend my Soul into the hands of my Creator who gave it and my body to the earth to be buried with decent solemnity without show or ostentation at the discretion of my Executor, and as to such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to intrust me, I dispose of the same as follows Inprimis. it is my Will and desire that all my just debts be paid out of such accounts, debts and demands which may be due and owing to me

at the time of my death. also it is my Will that the residue of my property be appropiated and bequeathed to my Wife Mary and child Henry Hunter Raymond to be appportioned agreeable to the Laws of the State and Lastly I appoint John Hunter Sole Executor to this my last Will and Testament.
