South Carolina. In the Name of God Amen. I William Pripsly of the City of Charleston in the State aforesaid, considering the uncertainty of life and being of sound mind and memory do make and publish this my last Will and testament in manner & form following, that is to say, First, it is my Will and desire that my friend Dr. James McLean of North Carolina and Benjamin Chambers of the Village of York do attend to my mercantile concerns, plantation and negroes in York District, and I do hereby appoint the said Dr. James McLean and Benjamin Chambers together with the Rev. James Adams Guardians of the persons and property of my children and to superintend their education and maintenance until they respectively attain the age of twenty one years or day of marriage. It is my Will and desire, that my friends Stephen Thomas and

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John Robinson do wind up the concerns of Phipps and Mandeville in
Charleston and of John Fountain & Co in Mechanicsville. The proceeds
of the crops and the profits of the stores in York District after payment
of debts there and the maintenance and education of my children
I direct to be remitted without delay to the said Stephen Thomas
and John Robinson to be by them appropriated to the payment
of my debts in Charleston. Item I give and bequeath unto each of
my nephews John Phipps son of my brother Samuel, and William
Phipps son of my brother John the sum of five hundred
Dollars to be paid to them as soon as it may be convenient.
All the rest residue and remainder of my estate both real and
personal, I give devise and bequeath unto my children to be divided
share and share alike, each portion to be allotted on arrival of the
age of twenty one years or day of marriage. And it is my earnest
request to my Executors herein after named that they would cause
the remains of my beloved wife to be removed to Bethel Church in
York District, and erect a monument ^{or other memorial} with a suitable inscription
over the grave. And Lastly, I do hereby nominate, constitute and
appoint my friends Dr. James McLean, Benjamin Chambers,
Rev. James Adams, Stephen Thomas and John Robinson Execu-
tors of this my last Will and testament, hereby revoking all wills
by me heretofore made. Fourteenth day of August 1819.
