In the name of God Amen I Thomas Franklin of State of South Carolina and County of Chester being Very Sick and Weak in Body tho in perfect mind and Memory and Knowing that that it is appointed for all men to die do Ordain this my last will & Testament, as touching Wordley Estate I give devise & dispose of the same in Manner & form following that is to say I---I give & bequeath unto my wife Priscilla all my Personal Estate that is to say all m. House hold Furniture with the stock of Horses Cows Hogs & Fowls with one Negro woman named Maggy Item I give & Bequeathe unto my Son John Franklin one Tract of Land Known by the name of Caldwell Tract & one Shilling Sterling if Required.

Also I give & bequeath unto Thomas Baker Franklin my son The Tract of land I now Live on Whom I also appoint Constitute & Ordain with my beloved wife Priscilla my whole & sole Executors of this my last will & Testament.

Also I give & bequeath unto my Daughters Frances & Mary & Elizabeth Franklins one Shilling Sterling if Required By Every of them freely to be possessed & Enjoyed and I do here by utterly Disallow Revoke & Disannull all & Every Other former Testaments Wills & Legacies Bequests & Executors by me & in anywise Before this time named willed & Bequeathed Ratifying and Confirming this and no Other to be my Last will & Testament In Witness whereof I have Hereunto set my hand & Seal this 4 th day January in the year of our Lord One Thousand seven Hundred & Eighty Eight Nine.
